Background

Countries are increasingly urged to foster partnerships and align workforce planning according to their climate ambitions. Skilled professionals play a key role in facilitating the green shift in businesses. It is therefore imperative for public education and training to work alongside companies to meet the skill requirements of job-rich sectors in the post-pandemic and green jobs expansion. The discussion will serve as a reference point for TVET institutions to learn about the different trends and priorities in business restructuring when they incorporate environmental, social and economic measures, ongoing partnership models, and innovative green skill development approaches.

Session objectives

The session seeks to explore the job-rich opportunities presented by climate change solutions that are being adopted to re-structure and adjust work processes in the industry and businesses. It will provide new insights into the different types and levels of engagement between industry and TVET agencies/centres/ providers to meet the skill needs in the post-pandemic recovery and green jobs and technology expansion.

The discussion will serve as a reference point for learning about business re-structuring priorities in Asia-Pacific region. It will also give some reference point to ongoing partnership potential/models /arrangements TVET has with the business sector/community. Through showcases and examples, the discussion will create opportunities to present skill development approaches in TVET agencies, schools and institutions to project skill demands, adapt training and harness TVET's role in climate change education and training, ensuring the development of relevant skills and competencies as well as the cooperation with business, community and social partners to succeed.
