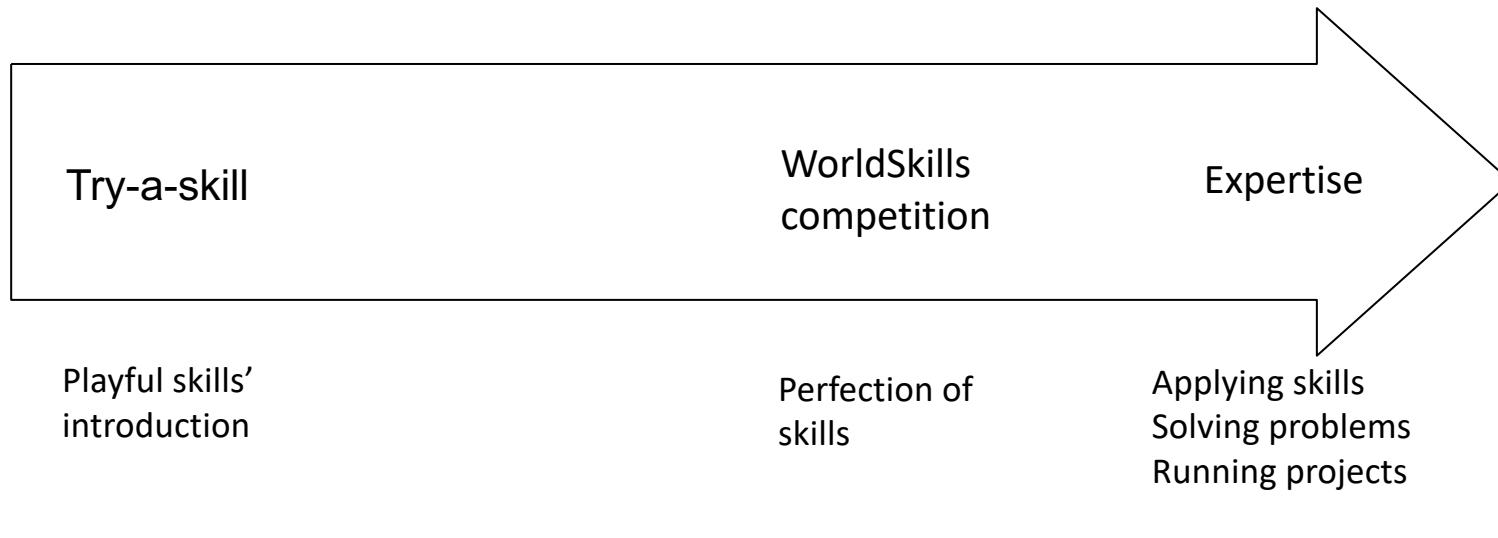

- Thousands young professionals every year

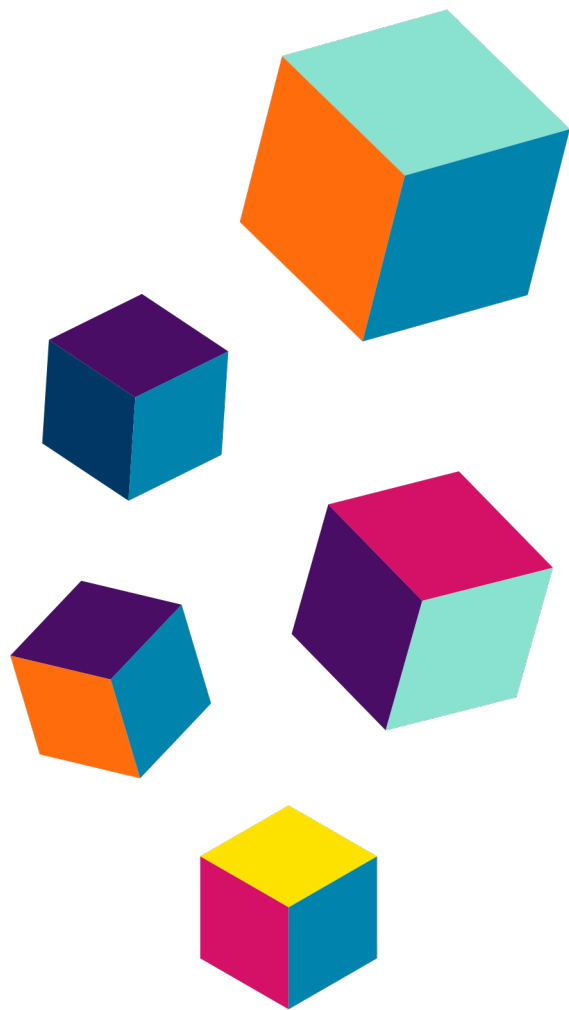
Abu Dhabi 2017:
