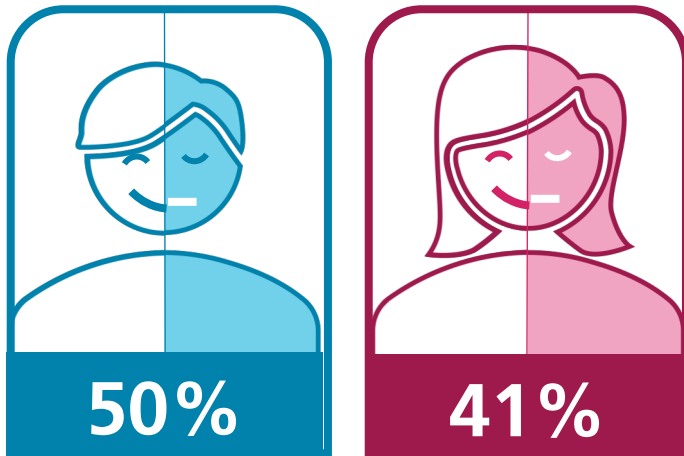
Coding: a men-only practice

In Europe, 4 out of 5 female students never engage in coding at school

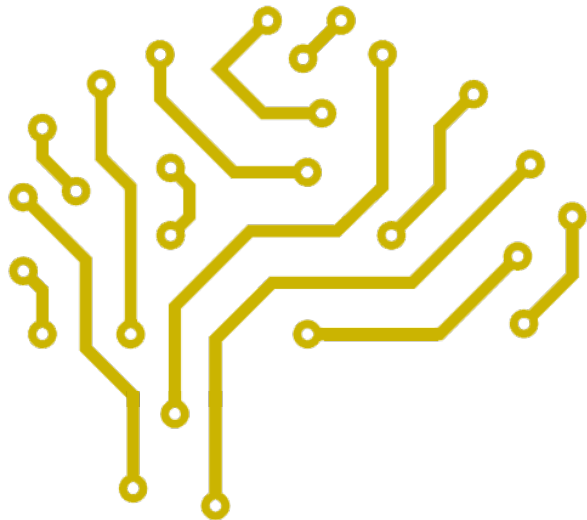

Gender disparities are more important than ever in the digital economy

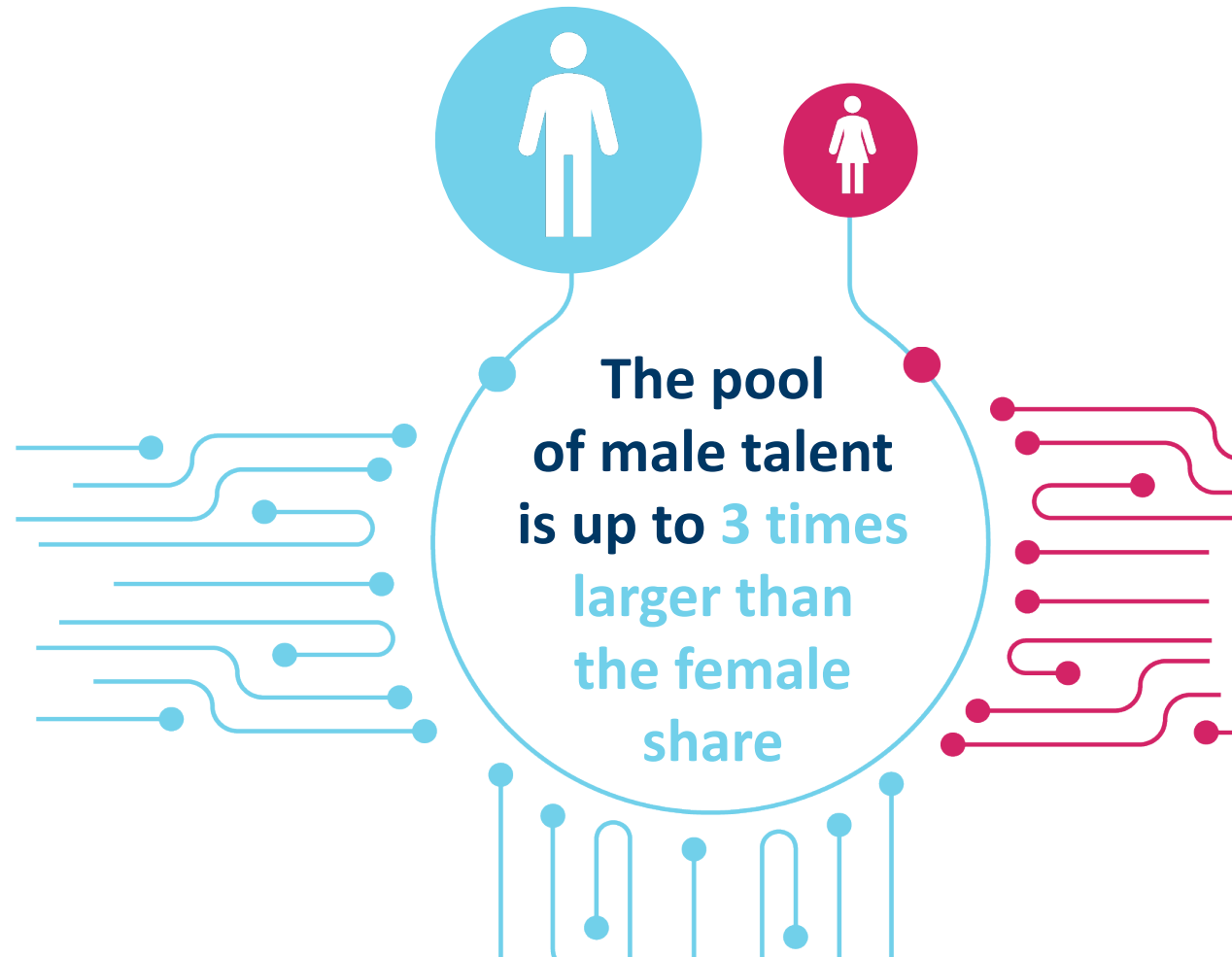


Globally, only 22%
