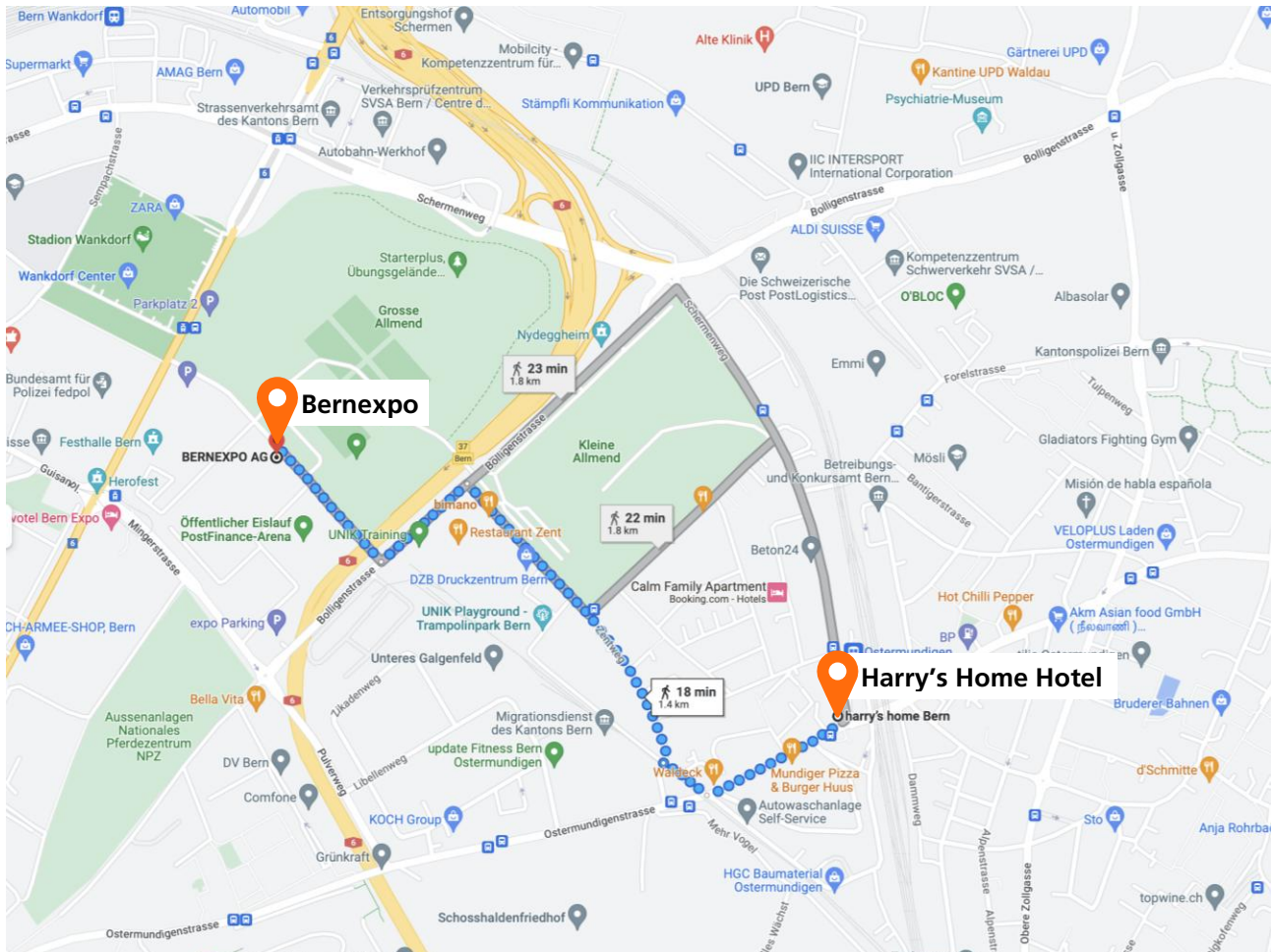

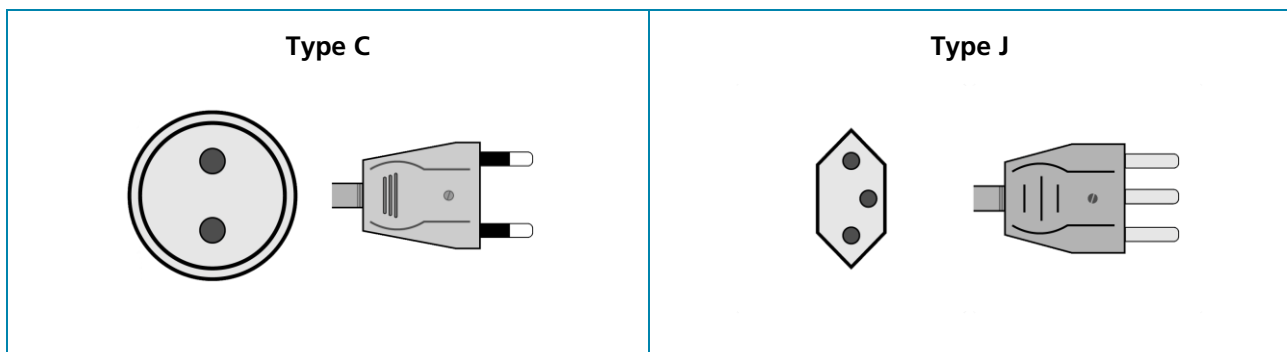
There are many ATMs (automatic teller machines) where you can withdraw cash (Swiss Francs) near the hotel and at the competition venue.

Power

230V 50Hz

These are the electricity plug-ins you can use in Switzerland.

Please note: It is the participants responsibility to ensure they have appropriate plug-ins and adapters where necessary, including Competitors for their skill tools.



Public transport

You can reach the BERNEXPO site by tram, bus or S-Bahn suburban railway in a few minutes from Bern central station.

- Tram No. 9 from Bern central station to “Guisanplatz Expo” stop
- S-Bahn (S1, S2, S3, S4, S31 or S44) to “Bern Wankdorf” stop, then tram No. 9 to “Wankdorf Center” stop
- Bus No. 20 to “Wankdorf Bahnhof” stop, then tram No. 9 to “Wankdorf Center” stop

SwissSkills – the Host Member – will provide the public transport plan and detailed instructions upon participants arrival (mainly C-4). Public transport will be free of charge for the participants with a full package.

Shopping

Essential shops can be found in Bern within close proximity to the hotel and venue as follows.

Taxis

There are numerous taxis available at the taxi stands at various locations in the city of Bern. Taxis can also be organized over the phone or stopped on the streets by waving.

The best way is to ask reception at your hotel, or you can use Bären Taxi 0800 55 42 32. Estimated cost from hotel to venue is CHF 25.

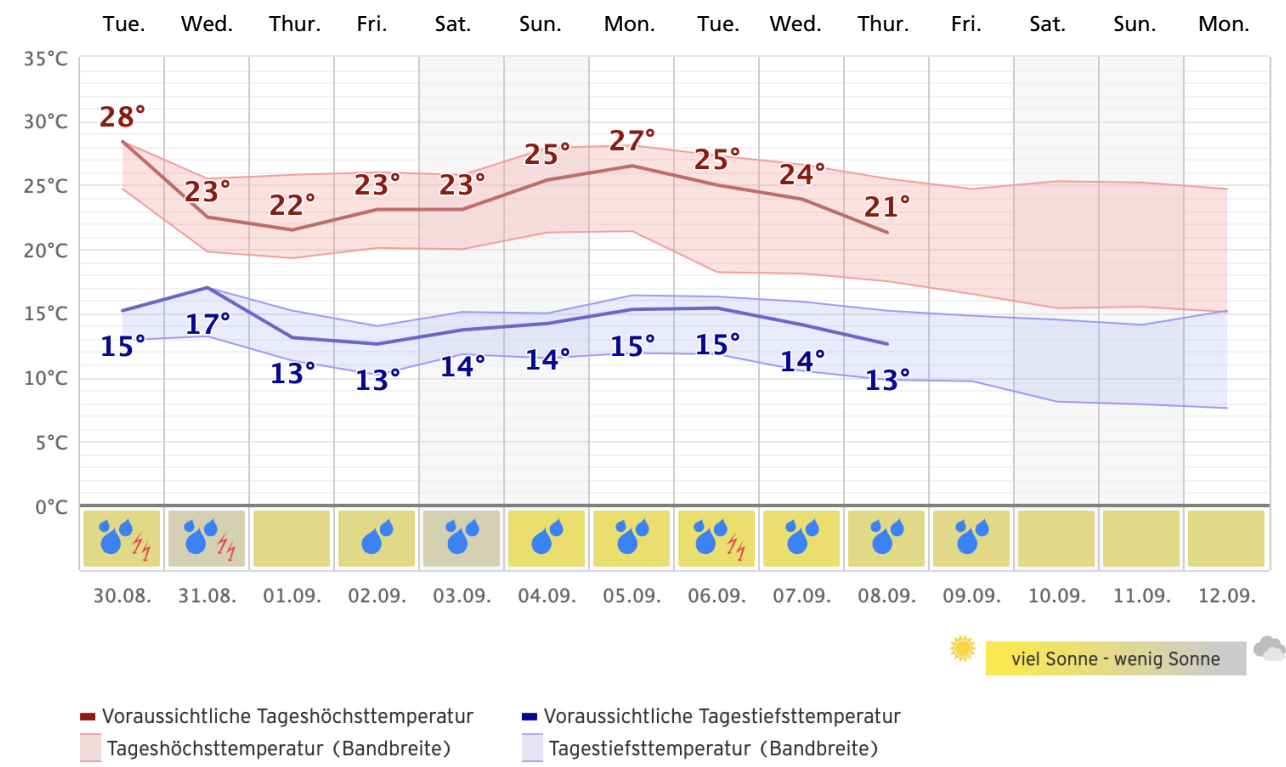
Please note that taxi journeys in Switzerland are relatively expensive in comparison to other European cities. Taxis are obligated to make their tariffs visible both inside and outside the car. Tips are included in the price. The ride can be paid for in cash or by card.

Weather

The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Bern in September is 9.0°C (48.2°F). The amount of rain in September is high with an average of 101mm (4.0in). It rains on average a total of 9 days. The average maximum daytime temperature lies around 19.3°C (66.74°F). The sun will occasionally show itself with 166 hours of sunshine during the whole month.

Visitors traveling to Bern should plan on bringing a totally waterproof rain jacket since it will often be raining. Plan on layering your clothes. Some days or part of the day it will be nice and warm and some moments it can be a bit chilly.

The bellow picture details current weather forecast for the week of Competition.



In case of rainy weather during excursions and for transfers the Host Member will provide rain jackets. The rain jackets must be returned.

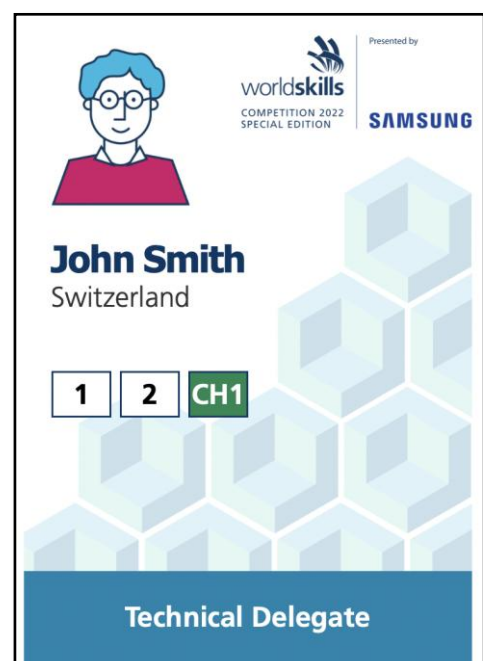
Accreditation

Daily transfers

Prevention and control of COVID-19

International travel procedures

- **General COVID-19 travel restrictions:** There are currently no restrictions due to the COVID-19 pandemic to enter Switzerland.
- **"3-G" rule (vaccinated/recovered or tested):** No proof of vaccination, recovery, or testing is required for entry into Switzerland.
- **Pre-Travel-Clearance:** Currently, no Pre-Travel-Clearance is required when entering Switzerland.

IMPORTANT: In addition to the Swiss entry regulations, please also pay attention to the current rules of your country of origin by checking the official government websites. Especially ensure that you have full understanding of the requirements for re-entry back into your own country as well as countries you might be transiting through when traveling.

Local COVID-19 procedures

- **COVID-19 rules during your stay in Switzerland:** There are currently no COVID-19 measures in place at a national level. Since the return to a normal situation, responsibility for measures to protect the population has moved back to the regions / cantons. The measures can therefore differ from one canton to the next.

- **Public meetings and events are allowed.**
- **If you have tested positive for COVID-19 during your stay in Switzerland:**
 - Inform others about your test result.
 - If you feel unwell, you should stay at home and avoid or reduce contact, especially with people at especially high risk.
 - High-risk group: If you belong to the especially high-risk group, consider contacting your medical specialist so that they can evaluate early COVID-19 treatment.
 - Mask: Wearing a mask when out and about is a good idea.

Competition COVID-19 procedure

- **COVID-19 rules at Competition venue:** There will be no other additional restriction other than current government guidelines.

Security

These are the security measure to enter the Competition venue for the general public:

- Maximum size of bag is 45cm x 45cm x 30cm
- Prohibited items:
 - Alcoholic beverages of any kind;
 - Pyrotechnic articles of any kind;
 - Weapons of any kind;
 - Gas spray cans and corrosive and colouring substances;
 - Glass bottles;
 - Mobile means of transport (exception: wheelchairs); and,
 - Animals (this regulation does not apply to service dogs, rescue dogs and dogs for the disabled).

WSC2022SE accredited participants can bring to the venue specific tools and toolboxes required for their Skill.

Visitors

No registration is required for the general public. Tickets can be purchased on site.

Ticket cost: CHF 15. Free admission to under 21.
