

There are many ATMs (automatic teller machines) where you can withdraw cash (Euro) near the hotel and at the competition venue.




Power

Weather

The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Nuremberg in October is 5.3°C (41.54°F). The amount of rain in October is normal with an average of 53mm (2.1in). The average maximum daytime temperature lies around 14°C (57.2°F). The sun will occasionally show itself with 115 hours of sunshine during the whole month.

Accreditation

Each person who is required to be on site outside the areas open to the general public before, during, and after the Competition is required to have an accreditation badge clearly displayed.

On arrival, full package holders will collect their accreditation from the hotel welcome desk.

Arrivals and departures

Upon arrival at one of the specified locations those with paid packages will be transferred to their hotel. Transfers will be scheduled according to the arrival details provided in the WSI Registration System.

When it is time to depart those with paid packages will be transferred from their hotel to the specified departure locations.

Arrivals services operate on C-4, departures services operate on C+2.

If you arrive one day prior to arrivals, or depart one day after departures, please contact the Host and to confirm if transfer arrangements are possible.

Multiple packages – for participants who have multiple packages, and your arrival and departure dates fall outside the two scenarios outlined above, you are responsible for co-ordinating your own transfers.


Competition venue

Event Wi-Fi

Competitors and Experts will receive access to the Wi-Fi at the Competition venue.

First aid

Onsite: At the Competition venue a first aid station will be available within the workshop and information will be given at the briefing onsite at C-2. For all injuries report them to the Expert, SCM or Host who will assess the requirements. If an ambulance is required one will be called on 112.

Outside venue: A pharmacy details can be found in the Shopping section above and can be used for minor injuries. Please advise Client Support of any injuries. For more severe injuries please call 112 for an ambulance and let Client Support know where they can assist.



Prevention and control of COVID-19

International travel procedures

- General COVID-19 travel restrictions: Currently there are no COVID-19 travel restrictions to enter Germany.
- Vaccinated, recovered or tested: For entry into Germany, it is no longer necessary to present proof of vaccination, proof of convalescence or proof of testing.
- **Pre-Travel-Clearance:** Currently, no Pre-Travel-Clearance is required when entering Germany.
- **Exception:** Countries where virus mutations are widespread are classified by the federal government as "virus variant areas." Special requirements apply to entrants who have stayed in such an area within 10 days prior to their entry into Germany. However, currently all countries have been cleared from the virus variant areas list. For latest information please check at:

IMPORTANT: In addition to the German entry regulations, please also pay attention to the current rules of your country of origin by checking the official government websites. Especially ensure that you have full understanding of the requirements for re-entry back into your own country as well as countries you might be transiting through when traveling as part of WSC2022SE.

Local COVID-19 procedures

• **COVID-19 rules during your stay in Germany:** Most COVID-19 restrictions have been lifted in Germany. However, basic protection such as mandatory face masking in hospitals or care facilities remain. Compulsory face masking in public transport can also be mandatory depending on each federal state / region. The mask requirement remains in place nationwide for long-distance passenger transport including air travel and rail travel.

PLEASE NOTE: Currently, the exact regulations are set individually by the respective federal state / region. The measures can therefore differ from one federal state to the next. Refer to bellow tab for individual states' official websites.

- Public meetings and events are allowed.
- If you have tested positive for COVID-19 during your stay in Germany: If you have tested positive for COVID-19 or suspect that you may be ill, it is recommended to stay home and avoid contact with other people.
 - Isolation ends with a negative nucleic acid test (e.g. PCR test) or at the earliest after five days following the positive test, if the affected person has been symptom-free for at least 48 hours, or at the latest after ten days.
 - It is recommended to wear an FFP2 mask outside your home / accommodation especially indoors for a further five days after the end of isolation and to avoid unnecessary contact with other people. Please check individual states on specific rules for isolation.

Competition COVID-19 procedure

• **COVID-19 rules at Competition venue:** No additional COVID-19 rules other than current government guidelines are planned during the competition in Germany.

Security

No specific security measures. Regular entrance and security check of the fair. Explosive items are not allowed.

WSC2022SE accredited participants can bring to the venue specific tools and toolboxes required for their Skill.

Any visitor for the WorldSkills event will need to submit their contact details via https://www.worldskillsgermany.com/worldskills2022se/nuremberg-eng/

The visitor will then get a direct link to the Fair to register for the Fair via the special link to receive entry at no cost. Visitors can only access the Competition venue on C1 till C4 during the open hours of the Fair.



Accreditation-only packages

For this special edition Competition, it was agreed that accreditation-only packages would be offered to participants who did not require a full duration paid package. This means that accreditation-only package holders do not have access to many of the services within the paid packages.

Accreditation

Each person who is required to be on site outside the areas open to the general public before, during, and after the Competition is required to have an accreditation badge clearly displayed.

Accreditation-only package holders will collect their accreditation from the registration desk at the Competition venue.

Important note

Members and Partners must understand that the Host incurs costs and administrative duties related to accreditation-only packages, therefore Members and Partners need to be considerate by providing accurate data.

All Members and Partners who have accreditation-only packages in the system need to assess their requirements and advise <u>client.support@worldskills.org</u> if there are any participants now not attending so these can be removed from the WSI system.

Please note that new accreditation-only packages cannot be added at this time.
