City information

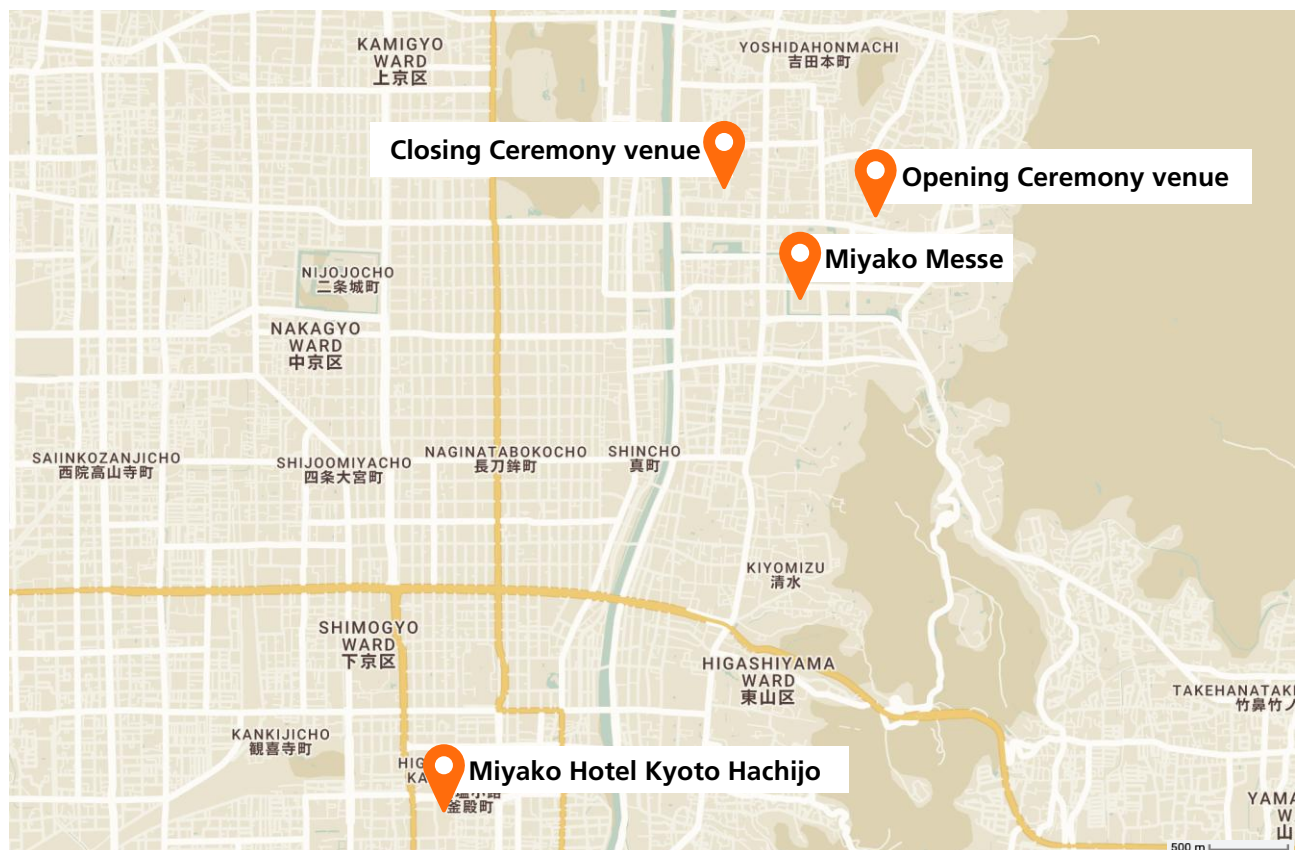
About ancient capital Kyoto

The major history of Kyoto (京都) starts as early as the eighth century CE when the city became the capital of Japan and home to the imperial court from 794 to 1868.

Thus, it was the birth place of the characteristic culture of Japan. Traditional arts such as Kado, the art of flower arrangement, and Chado, tea ceremony, bloomed in Kyoto.

Today, it is the capital of Kyoto Prefecture. Rich in historical sites, relics and monuments, the city attracts more than 30 million visitors every year.

Distance from Hotel to Venue: 5.2km 18min by shuttle bus

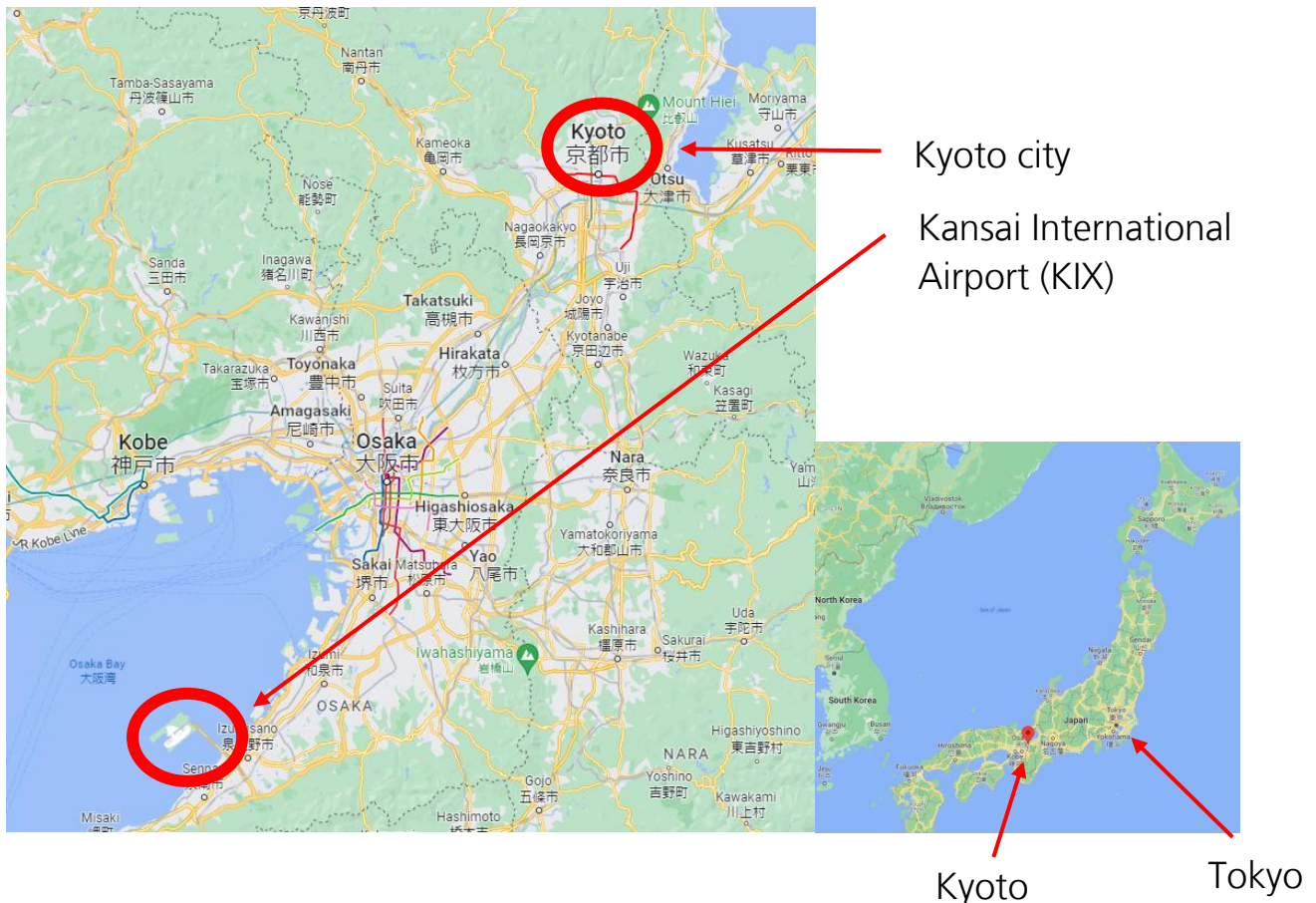

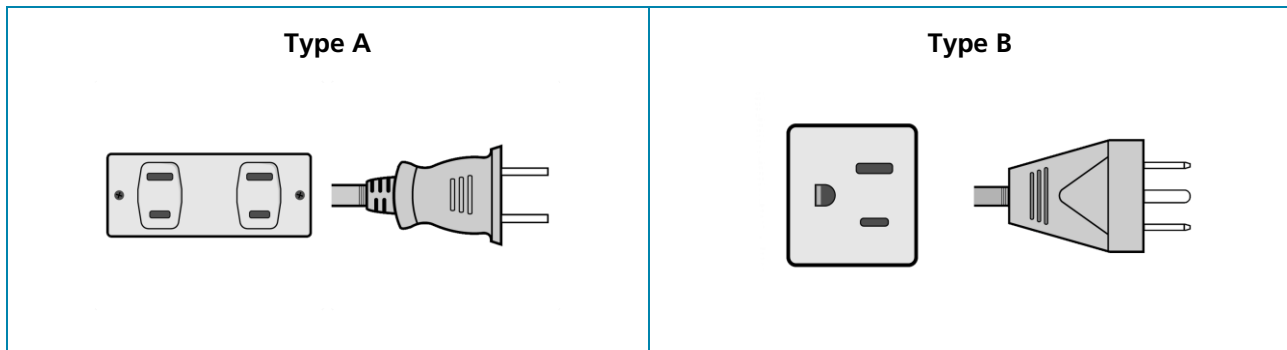

Weather

The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Kyoto in October is 14.0°C (57.2°F). The amount of rain in October is high with an average of 121mm (4.8in). It rains on average a total of 9 days. You can expect very pleasant temperatures during the day. The average maximum daytime temperature lies around 23.0°C (73.4°F). The sun will occasionally show itself with 160 hours of sunshine during the whole month.

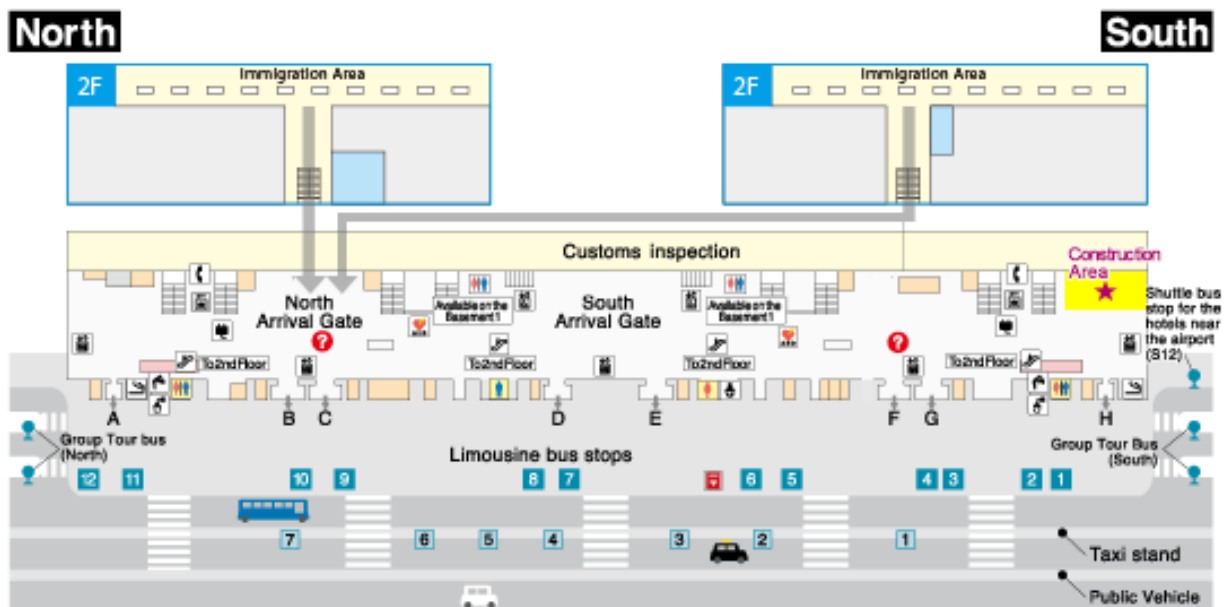

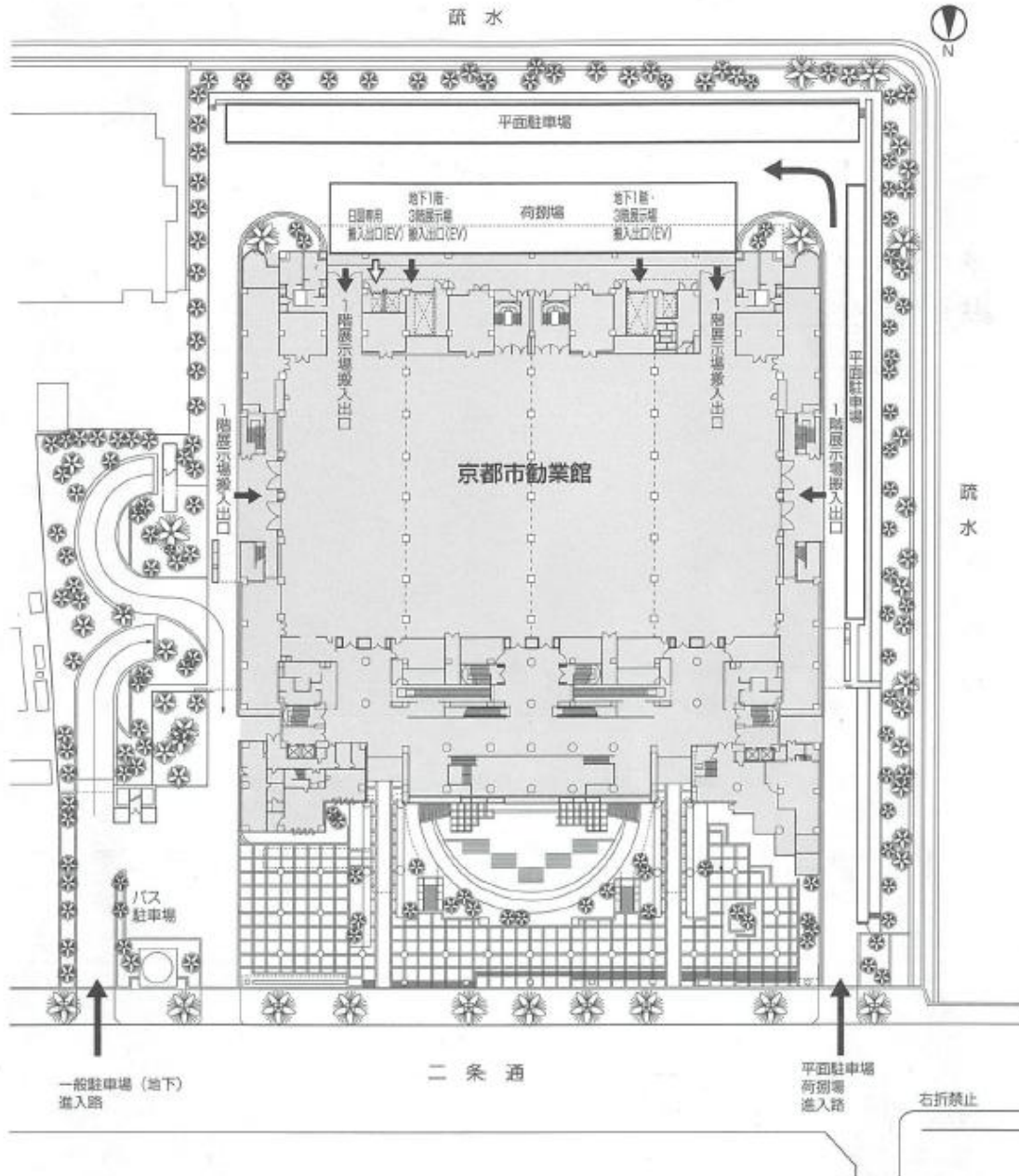

Event Wi-Fi

Free Wi-Fi at the competition venue is available to public.

Wi-Fi

SIM card needs to be prepared before your arrival, but in Kyoto there are many Wi-Fi spots : Hotel, Café, McDonalds, train stations, bus stops, etc. If you want to use Wi-Fi without limit, it is recommended to rental a Wi-Fi router. Wi-Fi is also available at the accommodation hotel and competition venue.

Local SIM cards

Local SIM card for use in Japan must be prepared before your entry to Japan. If it's difficult to prepare before entry, please purchase at the airport upon arrival. It costs approximately JPY 3,000-4,000 it depends on the amount of data.

WhatsApp group

Participants are encouraged to join this group to receive information during the event. Participants will not be able to post but will be kept up to gate if there are any announcements that they need to know.

Prevention and control of COVID-19

Change of Border measures

The government of Japan announced the new border measures will be applied, starting from 00:00 JST on 11 October 2022. Major changes from current measures are

1. For those entrants staying in Japan for less than 3 months for the purpose of business or for tourism for a short period, registration to the "Entrants, Returnees Follow-up System" (ERFS) will no longer be required.
2. In principle, testing for new coronavirus before (PCR testing 72hrs before boarding) and after entry will not be required, for those who already had 3-times vaccinations.

However, details of the new measures are still under consideration by the Japanese government. In particular, sorts of vaccines for testing exemption are not yet announced (e.g. treatment of Sinovac).

Requirements/exemption for visa will be separately announced from this measure. At this moment, it is planned visa for visitors from 68 countries will not be required as before.

We will watch out the latest announcements for the boarder measures of Japan and try to deliver to the participants to the WSC2022SE Kyoto, however, it is strongly recommended to keep on going your preparation for Japan entry under current measures as outlined below.

Before your departure

In Japan there are a classification of three categories for countries depending on the diffusion of epidemic level: blue, yellow, and red. By this classification, the quarantine level varies. For example, India, Vietnam and Kazakhstan are categorized in yellow as of 12 August 2022. Also please be noted that this classification is often subject to change.

As such, including the visitors from blue countries, vaccination of three times which Japanese government approve is highly recommended. Vaccination certificate can be approved with only valid vaccines by the Japanese government. Also please bring the certificate by electronic data or in paper.

- Every traveller entering Japan must submit a valid Covid-19 negative pre-test result. The pre-test must be taken within 72 hours before your departure of the origin country.

Note: This rule is currently under review and might change.

- Before entry to Japan, My SOS application must be downloaded. Please prepare smartphone or SIM card that functions in Japanese network in advance. You need to input necessary information for your entry to Japan and must show the screen at the quarantine for entry to Japan.

- In addition to the Japanese entry regulations, please also pay attention to the current rules of your country of origin by checking the official government websites. Especially ensure that you have full understanding of the requirements for re-entry back into your own country as well as countries you might be transiting through when traveling, as a requirement of covid-19 test in Japan before your departure.
- Please provide us your contact information for emergency cases, as well as the one of your affiliation as company or school.
- Please make sure to cover travel insurance, which covers covid-19.

Entry to Japan

- Port of Entry must be Kansai International Airport (KIX) in principle. If you choose other airports for arrival, please Inform WorldSkills Japan beforehand with a rational reason.
- If your flight passes stopover countries, please Inform WorldSkills Japan beforehand and be cautious that there's a possibility the classification changes for entry to Japan.

- We arrange a chartered bus from Kansai International Airport to the hotel for overseas participants and our staff will attend during the transport. Please follow the instruction of our staff. Route changing for visiting your friends is not available.

Local Covid-19 procedures

- **Covid-19 rules during your stay in Japan:** To prevent the spread of COVID-19 it is required that you take basic precautionary measures when in Japan including wearing a mask, washing hands, avoiding Three Cs: (close contact setting, closed spaces, crowded gatherings).
 - **Under current Japanese Border Measures, participants cannot personally act without special permission.**
 - **It is requirement to wear face masks. (Exceptions will be considered for a competition with physical work.)**
 - **It is prohibited for the participants (including competitors) to go out from the hotel at night.**
 - **It is recommended to keep social distance.**
 - **It is requested to refrain from going out without essential and urgent purposes. Please contact our staff for urgent cases.**
- **Public meetings and events are allowed.**
- **If you have tested positive for COVID-19 during your stay in Japan:**
 - A patient with mild or no symptom will stay at hotel. (There is possibility to be sent to another specialized accommodation.)
 - A patient with severe symptom will be transported by an ambulance to the hospital.
 - JAVADA / WorldSkills Japan staff and arranged travel agency staff will look after him/her until his/her departure from Japan.
 - Expenses for extension of staying in Japan will be borne by a participant in principle.

Competition Covid-19 procedure

- **Covid-19 rules at Competition venue:**
 - Body temperature of every participant will be checked before entering the competition venue everyday by organizer staff.
 - In case you get sick, please inform our staff immediately. If the test result is positive, you cannot continue your participation of the competition.

Penalties

- As a general rule, a penalty (disqualification from competition) will be imposed for failure to comply with the rules specified by the organizer.
- Corona related violations of 1, 2, and 3 below are subject to WSI treatment, with the first warning and the second suspension.
 1. Failure to comply with the organizer's instructions for medical treatment due to poor health, corona positive, etc.
 2. If a person is found to go out for non-essential reasons at night. However, people may use a laundromat or go out to buy food (about 30 minutes).
 3. In other cases, a competitor does not follow the instructions of the organizer during the competition.

In addition, visitors who do not follow the rules set by the WSI (Examples: Do not substitute for an interpreter to participate in competitions without WSI permission, do not enter restricted areas, etc.) may not be admitted to the venue.

Others

- No alcoholic drinks will be provided at Welcome/Farewell party.
- No planned evening events or receptions for Sponsors and Local Partners.
- In principle, staying in Japan after the competition finishes is not allowed.

Special instructions

WorldSkills Competition 2022 Special Edition Kyoto is an **Alcohol Free** event.

Participants are requested not to intake alcoholic drinks even after the daily competition time.

The turmoil by COVID-19 in Japan has recently been gradually mitigated, and entry into Japan for personal travel will re-start from mid-October. Restaurants have also resumed for business, although the wearing of masks is still basically required in the city. However, WorldSkills Competition Special Edition 2022 in Kyoto will not serve alcoholic beverages as well as the consumption of alcohol at one's own expense. This measure is applied not only for Competitors, but also for Experts, Observers, etc. This is of course to prevent the danger caused by drunken sickness, but the main purpose is to prevent the spread of the new coronavirus among those involved by eating and drinking without being silent while unmasked, which could also infect Competitors and consequently affect their participation to the competition and their performance demonstrations.

The following behaviours are banned:

- Drinking alcohol in restaurants or taverns in Japan.
- Going out at night for purposes other than shopping for commodities/meals or using the self-service clothes laundry.
- Gathering several people in the same room of the accommodation for the purpose of drinking alcohol.

Accreditation-only packages

For this special edition Competition, it was agreed that accreditation-only packages would be offered to participants who did not require a full duration paid package. This means that accreditation-only package holders do not have access to many of the services within the paid packages.

Accreditation

Each person who is required to be on site outside the areas open to the general public before, during, and after the Competition is required to have an accreditation badge clearly displayed.

Accreditation-only package holders will collect their accreditation from the registration desk at the Competition venue upon first entry to the venue.

Important note

Members and Partners must understand that the Host incurs costs and administrative duties related to accreditation-only packages, therefore Members and Partners need to be considerate by providing accurate data.

All Members and Partners who have accreditation-only packages in the system need to assess their requirements and advise client.support@worldskills.org if there are any participants now not attending so these can be removed from the WSI system.

Please note that new accreditation-only packages cannot be added at this time.
