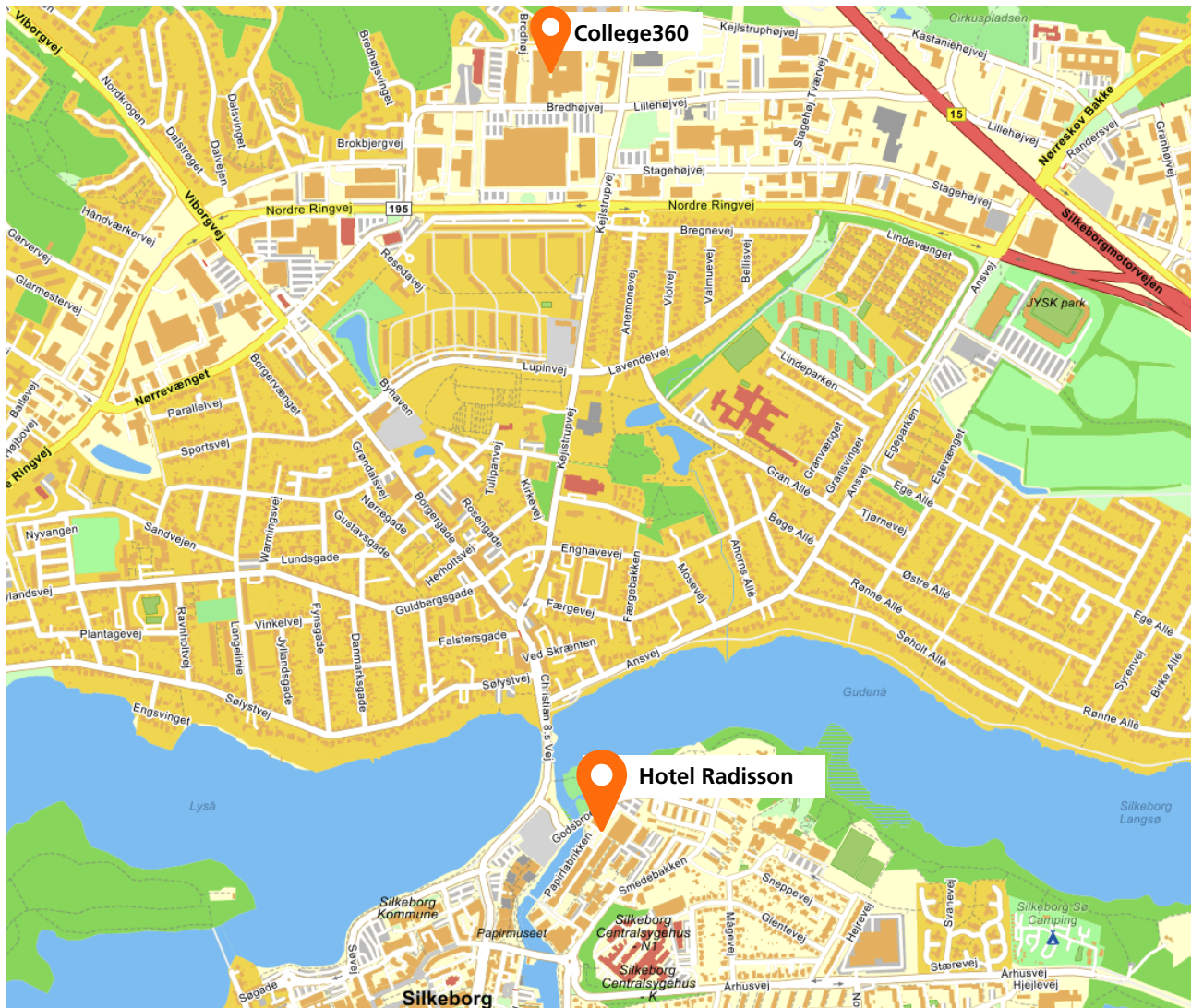

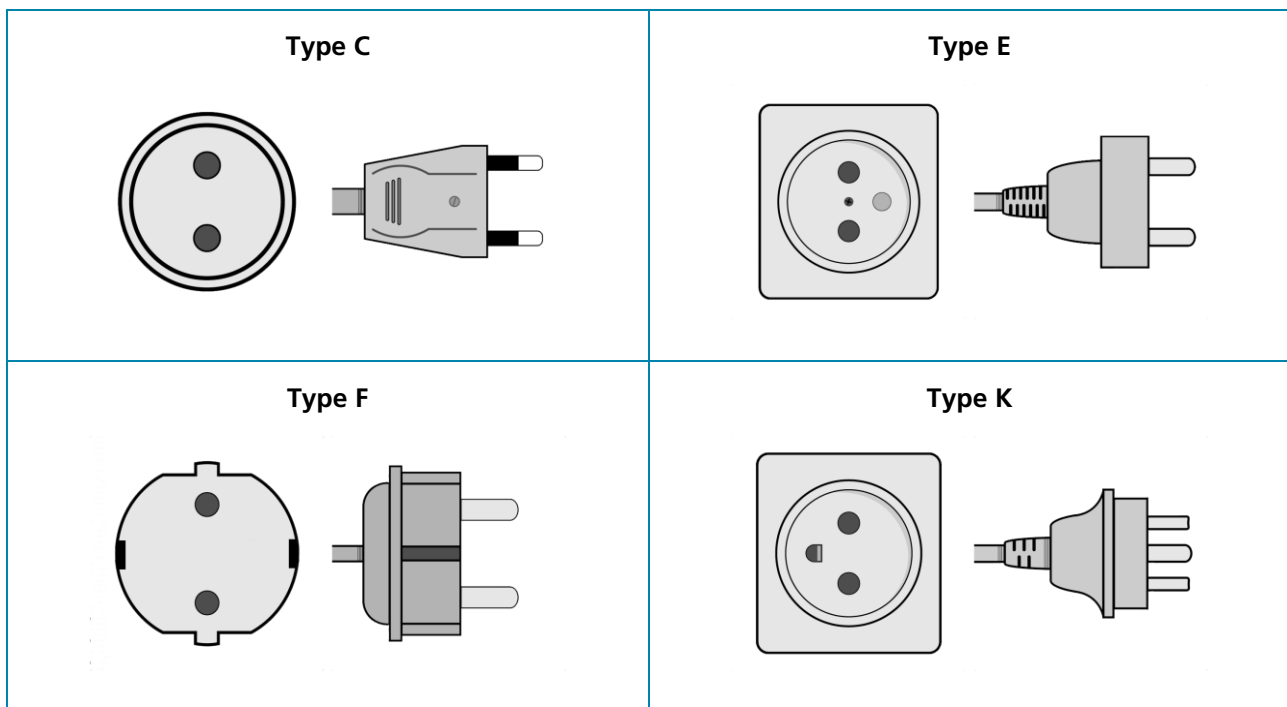
There are ATMs (automatic teller machines) where you can withdraw cash (Danish krone) near the hotel.

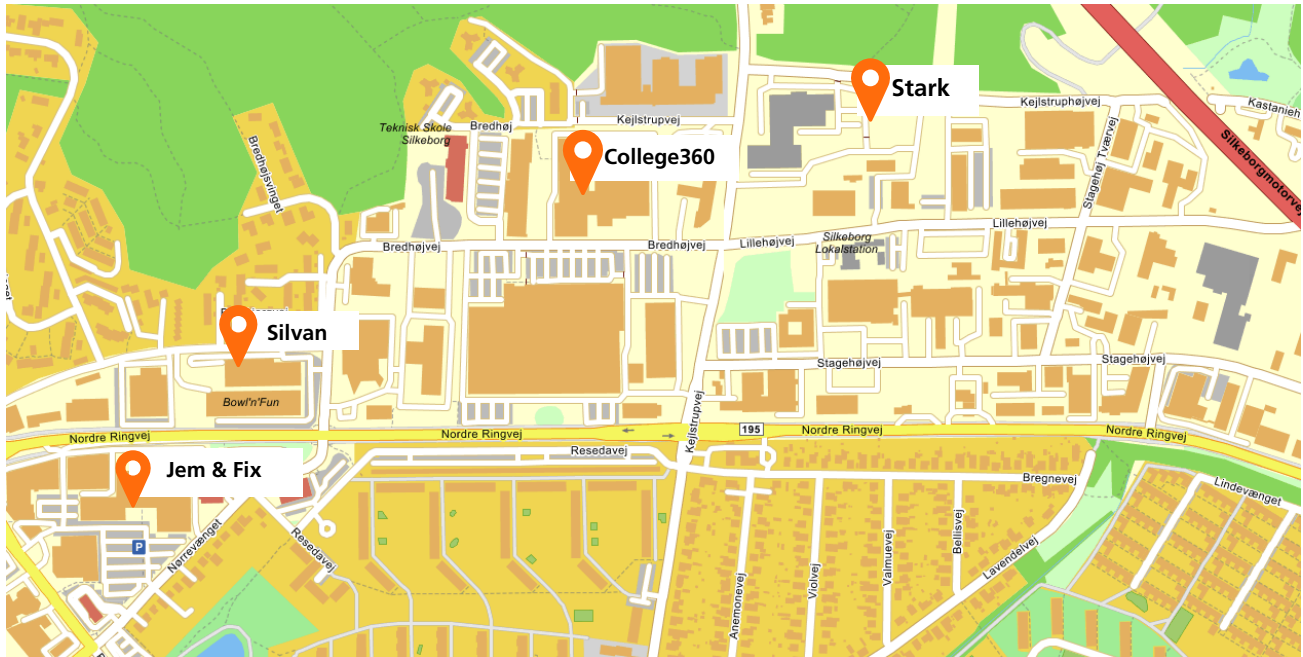

The prices vary depending on if you are going in the day or nighttime. For 10 kilometres the cost is approximately DKK 250.

Weather

The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Silkeborg in October is 5.0°C (41°F). The amount of rain in October is normal with an average of 90mm (3.5in). It rains on average a total of 16 days. The average maximum daytime temperature lies around 12.0°C (53.6°F).

The hotel is approximately 2.7 km from the Competition venue.

If arriving by car you have the possibility to park for free at "Smedebakkens Parking" right behind the hotel. You must register your name and plates at the tablet located in the hotel reception.

The registering will last for 24 hours, so remember to register daily.

For more or further information regarding the parking just ask at the reception or info booth at the hotel.

Accreditation

Each person who is required to be on site outside the areas open to the general public before, during, and after the Competition is required to have an accreditation badge clearly displayed.

On arrival, full package holders will collect their accreditation when arriving at the hotel.

Arrivals and departures

Upon arrival at the specified location at Billund Airport (BLL) those with paid packages will be transferred to their hotel unless otherwise have been agreed with the host. Transfers will be scheduled according to the arrival details provided in the WSI Registration System.

Arrivals services operate on C-4, departures services operate on C+2. If you arrive one day prior to arrivals, or depart one day after departures, please contact the Host and to confirm if transfer arrangements are possible.

Multiple packages – for participants who have multiple packages, and your arrival and departure dates fall outside the two scenarios outlined above, you are responsible for co-ordinating your own transfers.

When it is time to depart those with paid packages will be transferred from their hotel to the specified departure locations in Billund Airport unless otherwise have been agreed with the host.

Prevention and control of COVID-19

International travel procedures

- **General COVID-19 travel** restrictions: Currently there are no COVID-19 travel restrictions to enter Denmark.
- "3-G" rule (vaccinated/recovered or tested): Travelers are not required to provide proof of vaccination, recovery from COVID-19 or a negative test result.
- Pre-Travel-Clearance: Currently, no Pre-Travel-Clearance is required when entering Denmark.

IMPORTANT: In addition to the Danish entry regulations, please also pay attention to the current rules of your country of origin by checking the official government websites. Especially ensure that you have full understanding of the requirements for re-entry back into your own country as well as countries you might be transiting through when traveling as part of WSC2022SE.

Local COVID-19 procedures

- **COVID-19 rules during your stay in Denmark:** At this time there are no restrictions in Denmark.
- **Public meetings and events are allowed.**
- **If you have tested positive for COVID-19 during your stay in Denmark:** If you test positive for COVID-19 during your stay in Denmark, you are encouraged to self-isolate as soon as possible. If you have tested positive with a self-test, you no longer need to take a PCR test to have it confirmed. However, you are recommended to follow the Danish Health Authority's current recommendations for self-isolation:
 - If you experience significant symptoms, isolate yourself until you no longer have significant symptoms – but no less than 4 days (96 hours) from the time of the test. This means that you can stop self-isolating after at least 4 days (96 hours), even if you have mild symptoms such as runny nose, throat tickles, a few coughs, etc.
 - If you experience mild or no symptoms, it is recommended that you remain in isolation until 4 days (96 hours) after your positive test.

The event is open to the public on C1 to C4, during 09:00 and 18:00 hours. There will be an info booth at the entrance for any questions. The info booth will be staffed from 09:00-18:00.

Accreditation-only packages

For this special edition Competition, it was agreed that accreditation-only packages would be offered to participants who did not require a full duration paid package. This means that accreditation-only package holders do not have access to many of the services within the paid packages.

Accreditation

Each person who is required to be on site outside the areas open to the general public before, during, and after the Competition is required to have an accreditation badge clearly displayed.

Accreditation-only package holders will collect their accreditation from the info booth at the Competition venue.

Important note

Members and Partners must understand that the Host incurs costs and administrative duties related to accreditation-only packages, therefore Members and Partners need to be considerate by providing accurate data.

All Members and Partners who have accreditation-only packages in the system need to assess their requirements and advise client.support@worldskills.org if there are any participants now not attending so these can be removed from the WSI system.
