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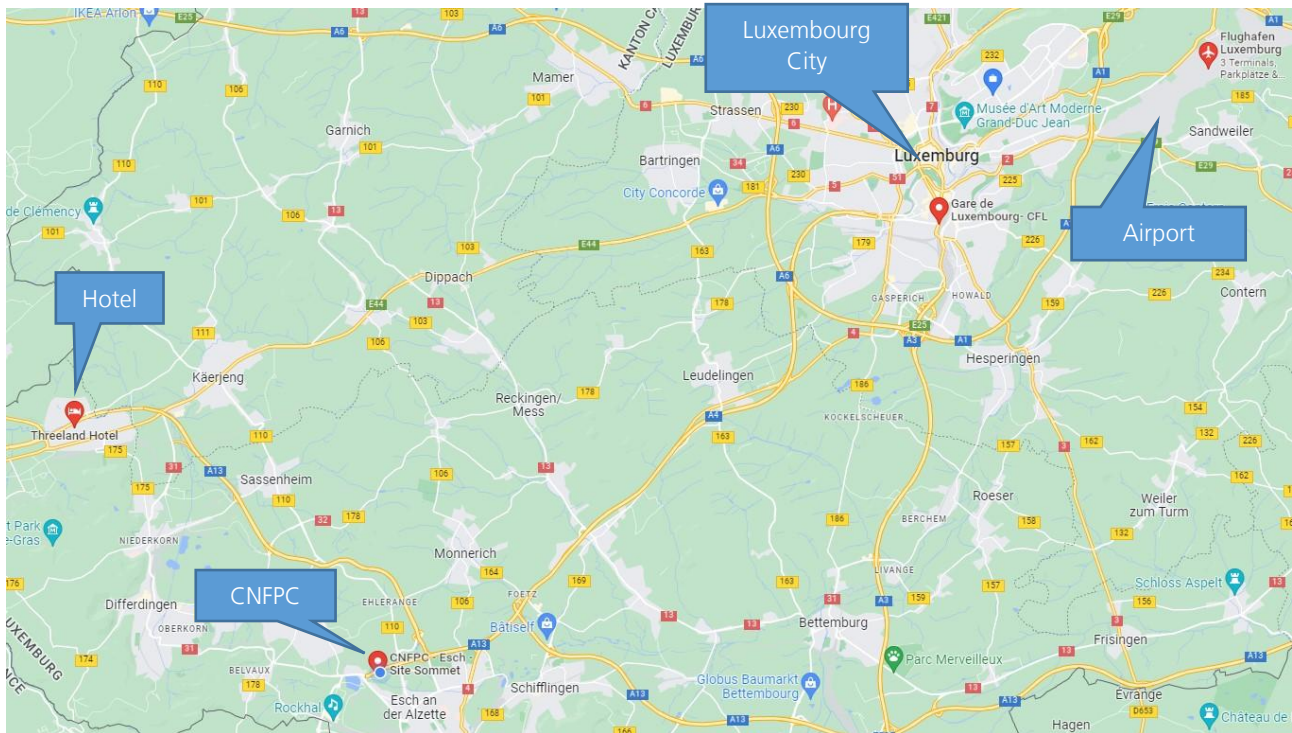

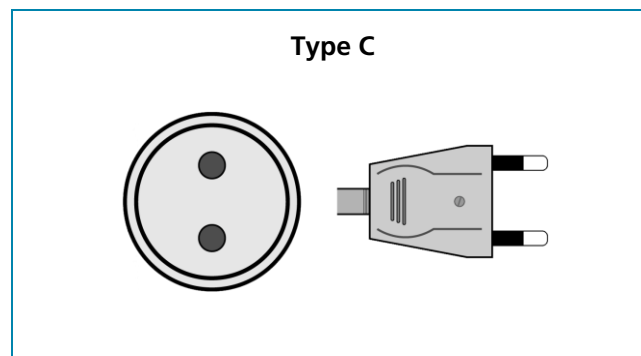
There are many ATMs (automatic teller machines) where you can withdraw cash (Euro) near the hotel and near the competition venue.

Public transport

Weather

The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Esch-sur-Alzette in October is 6.7°C (44.06°F). The amount of rain in October is normal with an average of 75mm (3.0in). It rains on average a total of 15 days. The average maximum daytime temperature lies around 13.6°C (56.48°F). The sun will occasionally show itself with 109 hours of sunshine during the whole month.

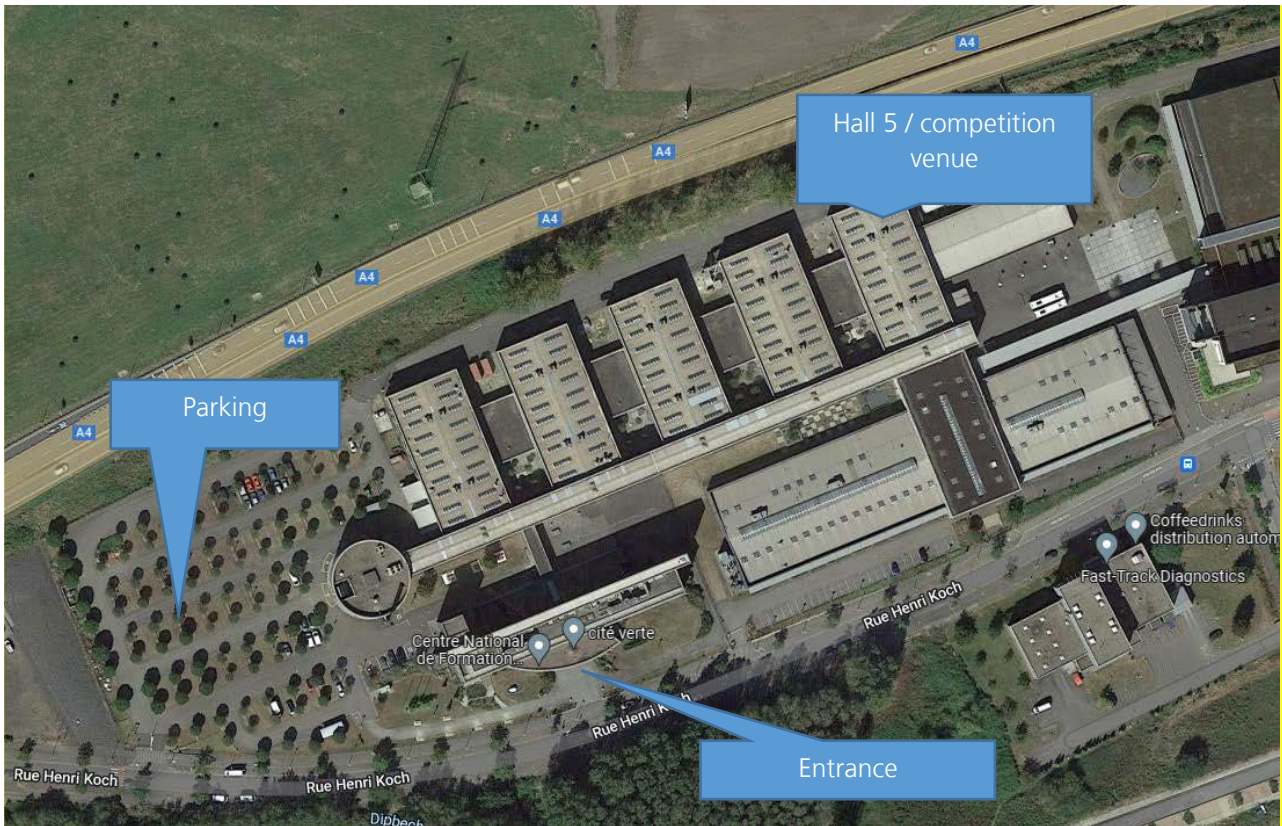

First aid

Health and Safety concepts and medical support are in line. A hospital is in proximity to the hotel and to the venue.

Onsite: At the Competition venue a first aid station will be available within the venue and information will be given at the briefing onsite at C-2. For all injuries report them to the Expert, SCM or Host who will assess the requirements. If an ambulance is required one will be called on 112.

Prevention and control of COVID-19

International travel procedures

- **General COVID-19 travel restrictions: Since 1 October 2022**, third-country nationals residing outside the European Union or the Schengen area may once again travel to the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg for all types of travel, including non-essential travel (e.g. for tourist or other reasons), regardless of their vaccination status.
- However, the persons concerned remain subject to the general conditions applicable for entry and stay of less than 90 days in the Schengen area, including in particular being in possession of a valid passport and, for persons subject to the visa requirement to enter Luxembourg, being in possession of a short-stay visa.

IMPORTANT: In addition to the entry regulations of Luxembourg, please also pay attention to the current rules of your country of origin by checking the official government websites. Especially ensure that you have full understanding of the requirements for re-entry back into your own country as well as countries you might be transiting through when traveling as part of WSC2022SE.

Local COVID-19 procedures

- **COVID-19 rules during your stay in Luxembourg:** Most COVID-19 restrictions have been lifted in Luxembourg. However, it is mandatory to wear the face mask in hospitals, nursing homes and medical facilities.
- **Public meetings and events are allowed.**
- **If you have tested positive for COVID-19 during your stay in Luxembourg:** If you have tested positive for COVID-19 it is recommend to follow these rules or contact the Covid-19 Helpline: +352 247-65533 (<https://covid19.public.lu/en/support/contact.html>)
 - Isolate for 7 full days after the date of appearance of symptoms or positive test result (PCR or certified antigen test)
 - Stay at home and isolate yourself from the other persons (if not possible › wear a mask)
 - Isolation can be terminated before the end of the 7 days if the infected person performs 2 antigen / rapid
 - self-tests at an interval of at least 24 hours, the results of which are both negative. This applies to both vaccinated and unvaccinated persons.
 - If a person tests positive, they cannot travel / leave the country. The person must be in isolation for 7 days and during the isolation, the person stays in the hotel even if the stay is longer than planned. The isolation can be terminated earlier if the person has a negative rapid test on 2 consecutive days.

- **COVID-19 rules at Competition venue:** No additional COVID-19 rules other than current government guidelines are planned during the competition in Luxembourg.

Security

WSC2022SE accredited participants can bring to the venue specific tools and toolboxes required for their Skill.

Visitors

The event is open to the public on C1 to C4, between 8:00 and 16:30. There is no pre-registration process for visitors.

Accreditation-only packages

For this special edition Competition, it was agreed that accreditation-only packages would be offered to participants who did not require a full duration paid package. This means that accreditation-only package holders do not have access to many of the services within the paid packages.

Accreditation

Each person who is required to be on site outside the areas open to the general public before, during, and after the Competition is required to have an accreditation badge clearly displayed.

Accreditation-only package holders will collect their accreditation from the accreditation desk at the Competition venue from C1.

Important note

Members and Partners must understand that the Host incurs costs and administrative duties related to accreditation-only packages, therefore Members and Partners need to be considerate by providing accurate data.

All Members and Partners who have accreditation-only packages in the system need to assess their requirements and advise client.support@worldskills.org if there are any participants now not attending so these can be removed from the WSI system.

Please note that new accreditation-only packages cannot be added at this time.
