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

There are many ATMs (automatic teller machines) where you can withdraw cash (Euro) near the hotel and near the competition venue.



### Weather

The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Brampton in October is 4.8°C (40.64°F). 
There is laundry and dry-cleaning service in the hotel.



## Prevention and control of COVID-19

### International travel procedures

- **General COVID-19 travel restrictions:** Canada travel restrictions are based on several criteria: your citizenship, mode of travel (water, air, land) and your vaccination status.
- Vaccinated, recovered or tested: Travelers are no longer required to provide proof of vaccination.
- To find out if you can enter Canada based on these criteria, please refer to the official website for exact information on which documents you need to provide or if you will be required to isolate based on your vaccination status: <u>https://travel.gc.ca/travel-COVID</u>.
- It is suggested to make the necessary arrangements for you to isolate for a maximum of 14 days (even if you believe that you will be exempt from quarantine based on your vaccination status):
  - Ensure that you have enough Canadian funds to cover your quarantine expenses (e.g., quarantine housing costs, food and basic necessities, transportation to your quarantine housing etc.)
  - Secure somewhere to stay during your quarantine, if you need a place to quarantine.
  - You also should not stay in a communal (shared bedroom space) or group setting with people you did not travel to Canada with while you are in quarantine.
  - Make arrangements for meals and other basic necessities during quarantine.
  - Make arrangements for direct transportation from the airport to your quarantine housing. Ensure you have a Canadian phone number that you can be reached at. You may order an eSIM card at <a href="https://gophonebox.com/">https://gophonebox.com/</a> that will be delivered to your email address so that you can have a working Canadian number when you arrive.

**Please note:** Final determination of your exemption from quarantine requirements is made at the port of entry. You must therefore be prepared to quarantine in case it is determined that you are not eligible for quarantine exemption. Entry to Canada is at the discretion of the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA). Upon arrival in Canada a CBSA agent will make the decision if you will be allowed entry into Canada or not.

### • Pre-Travel-Clearance:

- Travelers must provide mandatory information to the Canadian Border Services Agency (CBSA) but the use of the ArriveCAN mobile app is no longer mandatory but now recommended as it will allow you to clear customs more quickly: <u>https://www.canada.ca/en/border-services-agency/services/arrivecan.html</u>
- Review the Government of Canada's Quarantine Rules and Guidelines and their *COVID-19: Travel, testing and borders* website to ensure that you have the most update information and understand the entry requirements based on your vaccination status: <u>https://travel.gc.ca/travel-COVID</u>
- Read website: <u>https://www.canada.ca/en/public-health/services/diseases/2019-novel-coronavirus-infection/awareness-resources.html?travellers</u> for all up to date information based on your mode of travel.

**IMPORTANT:** In addition to the Canadian entry regulations, please also pay attention to the current rules of your country of origin by checking the official government websites. Especially ensure that you have full understanding of the requirements for re-entry back into your own country as well as countries you might be transiting through when traveling as part of WSC2022SE.

### Local COVID-19 procedures

- **COVID-19 rules** during **your stay in Canada and the province of Ontario:** Most COVID-19 restrictions have been lifted in Canada. However, face masking is still required in long-term care homes and retirement homes, and it is recommended to continue to wear a mask if:
  - you feel it is right for you;
  - you are at high risk for severe illness;
  - you are recovering from COVID-19 or have symptoms of COVID-19 or you are a close contact of someone with COVID-19 or symptoms of COVID-19.



- Public meetings and events are allowed.
- If you have tested positive for COVID-19 or start feeling unwell during your stay in Canada:
  - If you start having symptoms after you arrive, you should isolate
  - Self-isolate and manage symptoms:
  - If you are sick, stay home or isolate to prevent transmission to others, except to seek testing or medical care if required.
- You should stay home or isolate until all of the following apply to you:
  - your symptoms have been improving for at least 24 hours (or 48 hours if you had nausea, vomiting and/or diarrhea)
  - you do not have a fever
  - you do not develop any additional symptoms
  - When your symptoms are improving and you are no longer isolating, doing the following can provide extra protection against the spread of COVID-19 and other respiratory viruses circulating in the community.
- For 10 days after your symptoms started:
  - wear a well-fitted mask in all public settings
  - avoid non-essential activities where you need to take off your mask (for example, dining out)
  - avoid non-essential visits to anyone who is immunocompromised or may be at higher risk of illness (for example, seniors)
  - avoid non-essential visits to highest risk settings in the community such as hospitals and long-term care home.

#### **Competition COVID-19 procedure**

- Wearing a face mask at the WSC2022SE venue is recommended but not mandatory. It is required to follow the isolation rules as identified above and not participate in the Competition if you should be isolating. Hand sanitizer will be readily available at the venue to promote healthy hand hygiene.
- In the event WSC2022SE participants or attendees feel unwell, they must take certain precautions to limit the potential transmission of COVID-19 to others and manage their health and wellbeing.
- The first step for participants or attendees who start developing symptoms of COVID-19 at the event venue is to immediately notify their Expert, Chief Expert, Skills Competition Manager and/or Primary Contact Person.
- Proper steps, triage, and assessment must take place inside the skill area prior to determining next steps for this participant.
- Participants who notice COVID-19 symptoms or feel unwell outside of the venue (e.g., when they are at a restaurant or in their hotels), must return to, and stay in their room and isolate as soon as possible, notify their Team Attaché and/or Primary Contact Person. The affected individual(s) may complete the COVID19 self-assessment tool <a href="https://COVID-19.ontario.ca/self-assessment/">https://COVID-19.ontario.ca/self-assessment/</a> and follow the provincial guidelines in place. If they have concerns about their wellbeing, they can contact Skills/Compétences Canada or call 8-1-1 for additional guidance. If symptoms worsen, they must call 9-1-1 for medical assistance and notify Skills/Compétences Canada.
- Participants with symptoms of COVID-19 are not permitted to enter the event or venue and must self-isolate.



## Security

There are no specific security measures to enter the Competition venue for the delegates or general public. WSC2022SE accredited participants can bring to the venue specific tools and toolboxes required for their Skill.

## Visitors

The event is open to the public on C1 to C3, between 8:00 and 16:00. There is no pre-registration process for visitors.



# **Accreditation-only packages**

For this special edition Competition, it was agreed that accreditation-only packages would be offered to participants who did not require a full duration paid package. This means that accreditation-only package holders do not have access to many of the services within the paid packages.

### Accreditation

Each person who is required to be on site outside the areas open to the general public before, during, and after the Competition is required to have an accreditation badge clearly displayed.

Accreditation-only package holders will collect their accreditation from the registration desk at the Competition venue.

### Important note

Members and Partners must understand that the Host incurs costs and administrative duties related to accreditation-only packages, therefore Members and Partners need to be considerate by providing accurate data.

All Members and Partners who have accreditation-only packages in the system need to assess their requirements and advise <u>client.support@worldskills.org</u> if there are any participants now not attending so these can be removed from the WSI system.

Please note that new accreditation-only packages cannot be added at this time.
