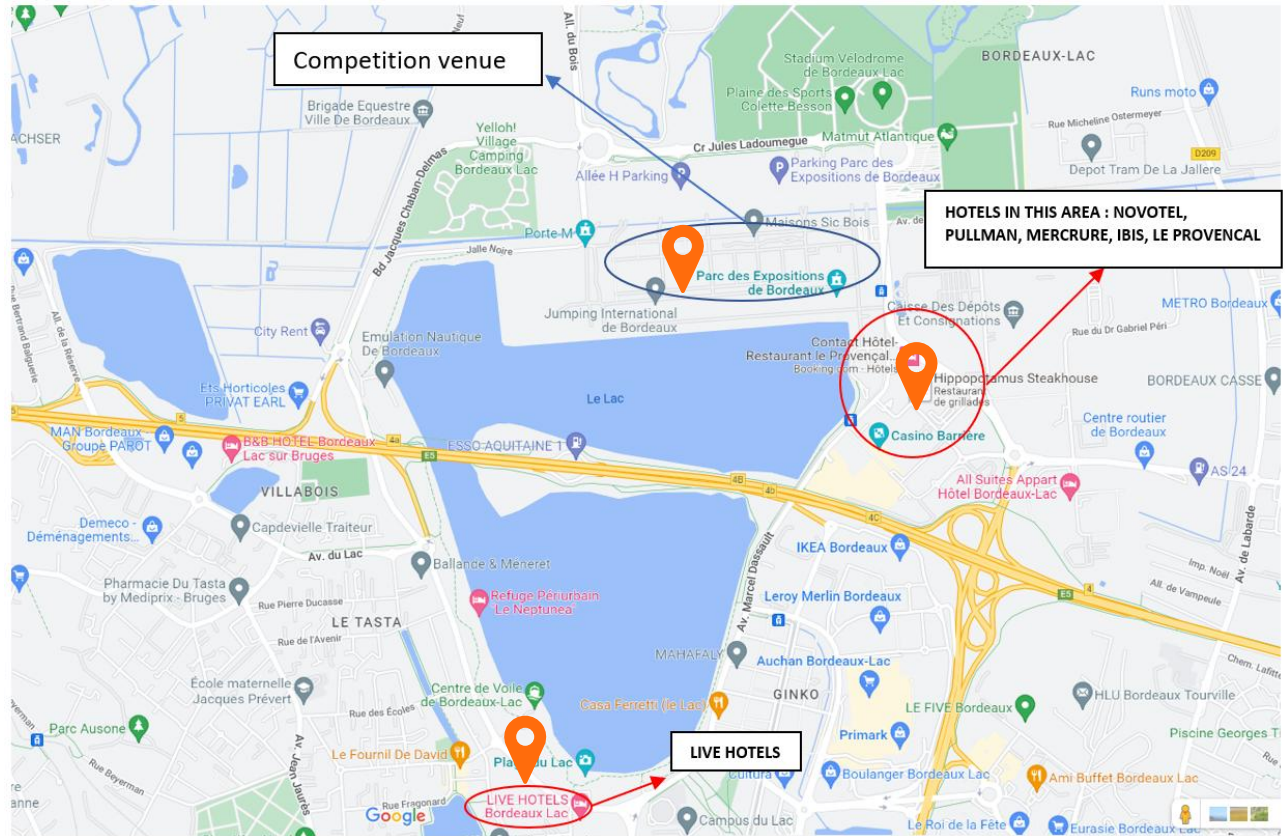

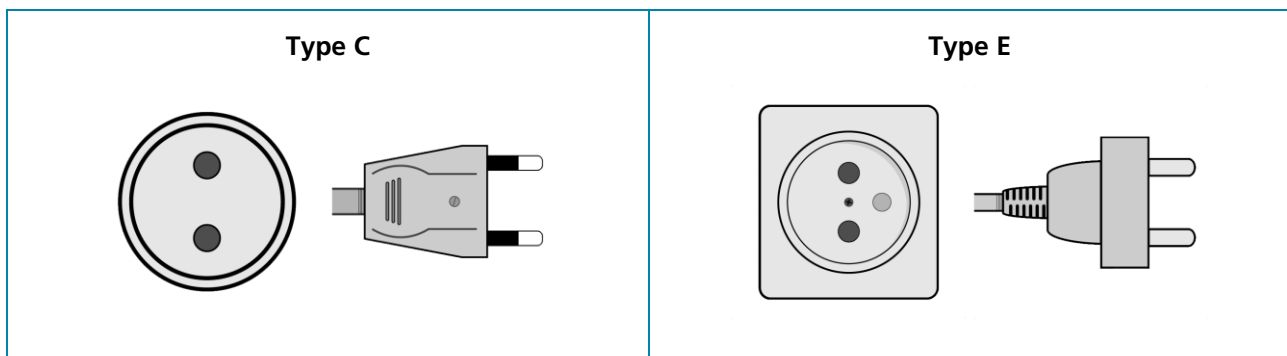
There are many ATMs (automatic teller machines) where you can withdraw cash (Euro) near the hotel and at the competition venue.

Weather

The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Bordeaux in October is 10.3°C (50.54°F). The amount of rain in October is high with an average of 94mm (3.7in). It rains on average a total of 11 days. You can expect very pleasant temperatures during the day. The average maximum daytime temperature lies around 19.5°C (67.1°F). The sun will occasionally show itself with 145 hours of sunshine during the whole month.

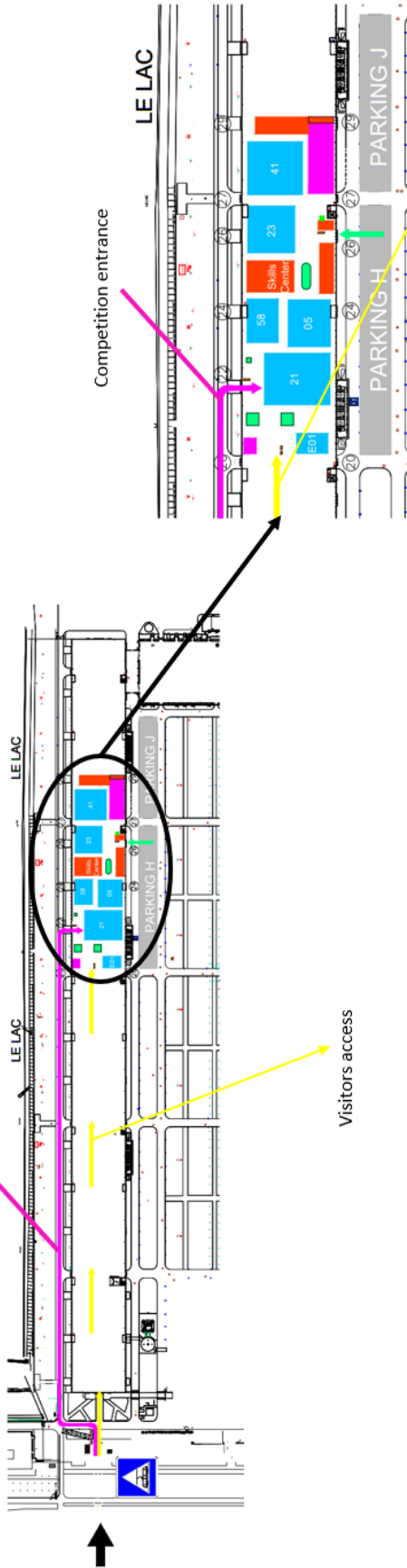

Daily transfers

Prevention and control of COVID-19

International travel procedures

- **General COVID-19 travel restrictions:** Currently there are no COVID-19 travel restrictions to enter France.
- **Vaccinated, recovered or tested:** Travelers are not required to provide proof of vaccination, recovery from COVID-19 or a negative test result.
- **Pre-Travel-Clearance:** Currently, no Pre-Travel-Clearance is required when entering France.

IMPORTANT: In addition to the French entry regulations, please also pay attention to the current rules of your country of origin by checking the official government websites. Especially ensure that you have full understanding of the requirements for re-entry back into your own country as well as countries you might be transiting through when traveling as part of WSC2022SE.

If any WSC2022SE participants require a PCR test before their return to their own country, WorldSkills France will organize a test day in a pre-determined place. Please, click on the link below and fill in the information required by WorldSkills France to be able to organise the PCR tests.

Local COVID-19 procedures

- **COVID-19 rules during your stay in France:** Currently, there are no restrictions in France.
- **Public meetings and events are allowed.**
- **If you have tested positive for COVID-19 during your stay in France:** If you have tested COVID-19 positive and are fully vaccinated, you should isolate for a period of 7 (full) days from the date of the start of the symptoms or the date of the positive test. However, after 5 days you can leave isolation on two conditions:
 - if you perform an antigen or RT-PCR test and it is negative.
 - if you have had no clinical signs of infection for 48 hours.
- If the second test (on day 5) is positive or you have not done the second test, the isolation is 7 days. It is not necessary to perform a second test on day 7 (last day of isolation) anymore.
- If you have tested COVID-19 positive and are non-vaccinated or not fully vaccinated, isolation is 10 (full) days from the date of the start of the symptoms or the date of the sample positive test. However, after 7 days you can leave isolation on two conditions:
 - if you perform an antigen or RT-PCR test and it is negative.
 - if you have had no clinical signs of infection for 48 hours.
- If the second test (on day 7) is positive or you have not done the second test, the isolation is 10 days.
- **Please note:** A face mask should be worn for 7 days after the isolation is finished.
- In the event of a positive test, you must fill in the list of people with whom you have been in contact in the 48 hours before the first symptoms or positive test result on the free Health Insurance helpline: +33 (0) 800130000 and inform the people on this list about your COVID-19 status.

Competition COVID-19 procedure

- **COVID-19 rules at Competition venue:** WorldSkills France requires wearing a face mask (for example FFP2, KN95, or similar) during the Competition. This is a requirement to protect yourself and others from spreading COVID-19 virus. Should a specific skill workshop require particular PPE for Health & Safety reasons, these must be followed as well.
- Worldskills France has a contact with several nursing offices to perform tests directly on site in case of symptoms. The procedure will be provided in the "Welcome Bag".

Security

All Bags will be checked at the venue entrance. Please note that all weapons or sharp objects and/or drugs are prohibited.

WSC2022SE accredited participants can bring to the venue specific tools and toolboxes required for their Skill.

The event is open to the public on C1 to C4 from 09:00 to 17:00. When arriving at the venue, visitors follow the entrance signage to arrive at the visitor welcome counter. Visitors will register and receive a daily access pass. There is no requirement for visitors to pre-register.

Accreditation-only packages

For this special edition Competition, it was agreed that accreditation-only packages would be offered to participants who did not require a full duration paid package. This means that accreditation-only package holders do not have access to many of the services within the paid packages.

Accreditation-only package holders will collect their accreditation from the registration desk at the Competition venue located at entry 22 "Competition Access".

Important note

Members and Partners must understand that the Host incurs costs and administrative duties related to accreditation-only packages, therefore Members and Partners need to be considerate by providing accurate data.

All Members and Partners who have accreditation-only packages in the system need to assess their requirements and advise client.support@worldskills.org if there are any participants now not attending so these can be removed from the WSI system.
