Clock changes

On Sunday, 30 October British Summer Time ends, and we return to Greenwich Mean Time. This means the clocks will be put back one hour at 02:00.





Power

For United Kingdom the associated plug type is G, which is the plug that three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern. United Kingdom operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz.

Please note: It is the participants responsibility to ensure they have appropriate plug-ins and adapters where necessary, including Competitors for their skill tools.



Public transport

Minibuses have been booked to transport competitors to and from the venue, leaving the hotel at 06:00 and 06:30 each morning. Return journeys have also been booked at 19:00 and 19:30.

Travel to the venue via public bus should take 1 hour and 24 minutes via route 304. Travel via car will take 27 minutes

Weather

The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Cardiff in November is 5.2°C (41.36°F). The amount of rain in November is high with an average of 132mm (5.2in). It rains on average a total of 16 days. The average maximum daytime temperature lies around 11.5°C (52.7°F). You will hardly see any sun with 66 hours of sunshine during the whole month.

Prevention and control of COVID-19

International travel procedures

- General COVID-19 travel restrictions: Currently there are no COVID-19 travel restrictions to enter United Kingdom and Wales.
- Vaccinated, recovered or tested: Travelers are not required to provide proof of vaccination, recovery from COVID-19 or a negative test result.
- **Pre-Travel-Clearance:** Currently, no Pre-Travel-Clearance is required when entering Wales.

IMPORTANT: In addition to the Welsh entry regulations, please also pay attention to the current rules of your country of origin by checking the official government websites. Especially ensure that you have full understanding of the requirements for re-entry back into your own country as well as countries you might be transiting through when traveling as part of WSC2022SE.

Local COVID-19 procedures

- COVID-19 rules during your stay in Wales: At this time there are no restrictions in Wales.
- Public meetings and events are allowed.
- If you have tested positive for COVID-19 during your stay in Wales: If you have a positive COVID-19 test result, it is recommended to stay at home and avoid contact with other people. You should advise all close contacts about your positive COVID-19 test result. It is recommended to avoid contact with other people for at least 5 days after the day you took your test, or from the day your symptoms started (whichever was earlier). Some people may be infectious for up to 10 days from the start of their infection. You should therefore avoid meeting anyone who is at higher risk for 10 days.

• **COVID-19 rules at Competition venue:** No additional COVID-19 rules other than current government guidelines are planned during the competition in England or Wales.

Security

WSC2022SE accredited participants can bring to the venue specific tools and toolboxes required for their Skill.

Visitors

The event is open to the public on C1 to C4, between 9:00 and 16:00. There is no pre-registration process for visitors.



Accreditation-only packages

For this special edition Competition, it was agreed that accreditation-only packages would be offered to participants who did not require a full duration paid package. This means that accreditation-only package holders do not have access to many of the services within the paid packages.

Accreditation

Each person who is required to be on site outside the areas open to the general public before, during, and after the Competition is required to have an accreditation badge clearly displayed.

Accreditation-only package holders will collect their accreditation from the registration desk at the Competition venue.

Important note

Members and Partners must understand that the Host incurs costs and administrative duties related to accreditation-only packages, therefore Members and Partners need to be considerate by providing accurate data.

All Members and Partners who have accreditation-only packages in the system need to assess their requirements and advise <u>client.support@worldskills.org</u> if there are any participants now not attending so these can be removed from the WSI system.

Please note that new accreditation-only packages cannot be added at this time.
