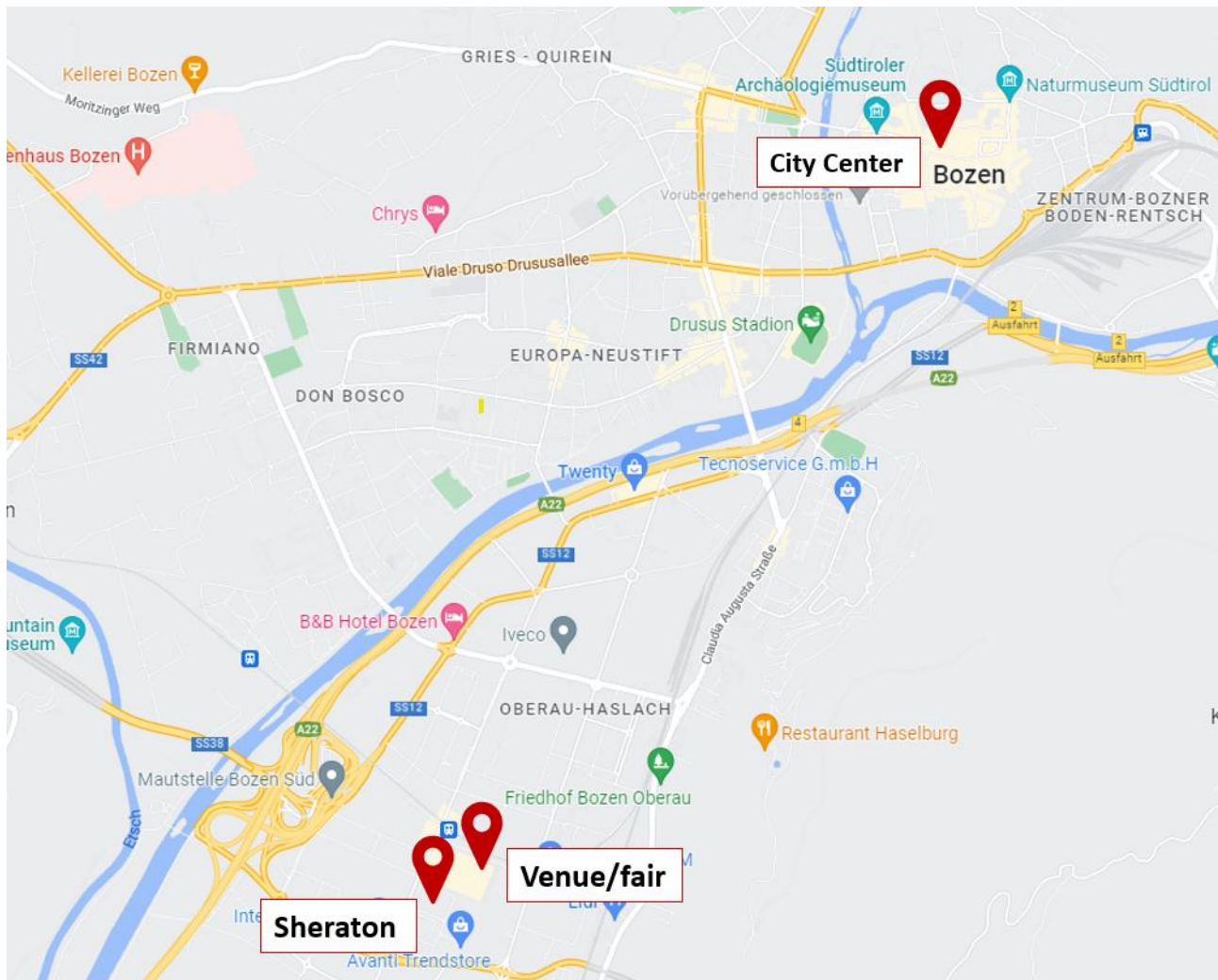

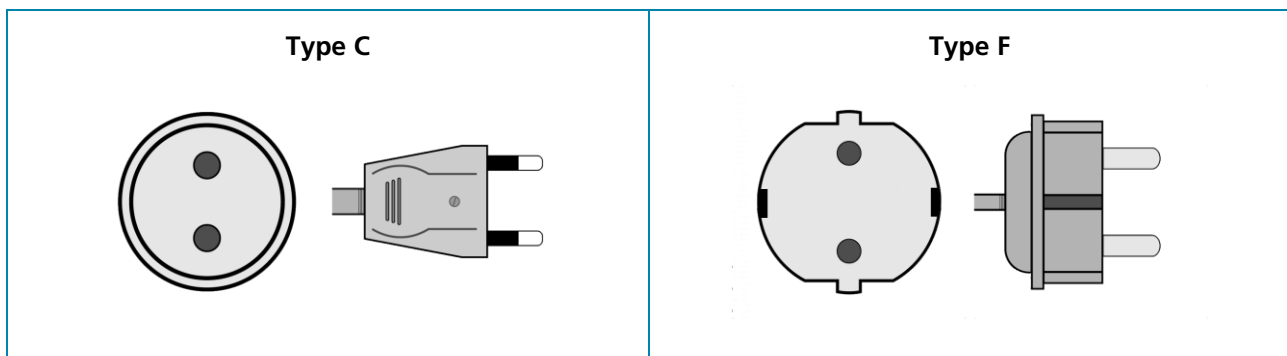
There are many ATMs (automatic teller machines) where you can withdraw cash (euro) near the hotel and at the competition venue.

Power

Please note: It is the participants responsibility to ensure they have appropriate plug-ins and adapters where necessary, including Competitors for their skill tools.



Public transport

The Hotel is walking distance to the competition venue.


To get to the city centre:

- Railway Station Bolzano South near the Sheraton Hotel, Train Line 1 (The train leaves every half hour)
- Bus station Bolzano South near the Sheraton Hotel, Line 10A and 10B (The city bus leaves every 12 minutes)


Public transport will be free of charge for the participants with a full package and accreditation-only package (C-4 to C+2). On arrival, badges, welcome gifts, and tickets for free use of public transport (A4 sheet) are handed out at the Info-Desk in the Sheraton Hotel before dinner.

The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Bolzano in November is 0.6°C (32°F). The amount of rain in November is normal with an average of 86mm (3.4in). It rains on average a total of 8 days. The average maximum daytime temperature lies around 11.0°C (51.8°F). The sun will occasionally show itself with 102 hours of sunshine during the whole month. Plan to bring a waterproof rain jacket and warm clothes, it can be a bit chilly during this period.

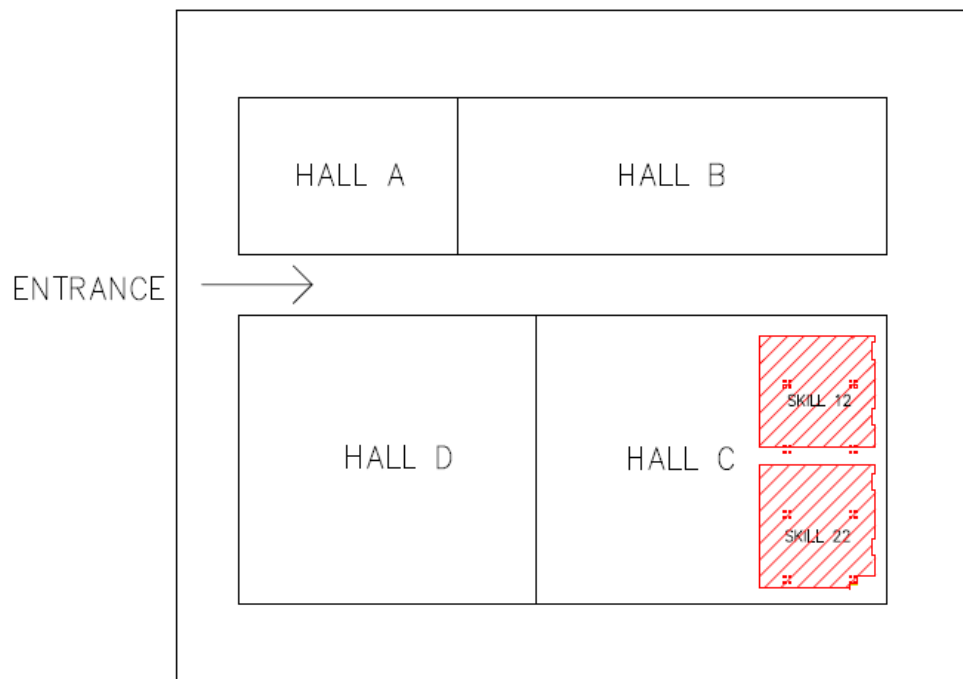

Prevention and control of COVID-19

International travel procedures

- **General COVID-19 travel restrictions:** Currently there are no COVID-19 travel restrictions to enter Italy.
- **Vaccinated, recovered or tested:** Travelers are not required to provide proof of vaccination, recovery from COVID-19 or a negative test result.
- **Pre-Travel-Clearance:** Currently, no Pre-Travel-Clearance is required when entering Italy.

IMPORTANT: In addition to the Italian entry regulations, please also pay attention to the current rules of your country of origin by checking the official government websites. Especially ensure that you have full understanding of the requirements for re-entry back into your own country as well as countries you might be transiting through when traveling as part of WSC2022SE.

Local COVID-19 procedures

- **COVID-19 rules during your stay in Italy:** Most COVID-19 restrictions have been lifted in Italy. Workers, users and visitors of healthcare, social-health and social-assistance facilities are required to wear masks.
- **Public meetings and events are allowed.**
- **If you have tested positive for COVID-19 during your stay in Italy:** Persons with symptoms of COVID-19 should immediately inform the Prevention Department of the Local Health Authority, remain in isolation with an absolute ban on mobility and follow the instructions of health personnel. The Prevention Department can be contacted:
 - through accommodation / hotel staff;
 - by calling the regional toll-free numbers: +39 (0) 800 751 751;
 - in case of severe symptoms, contact the emergency number 112;

Competition COVID-19 procedure

- **COVID-19 rules at Competition venue:** Respiratory protection (=face mask, for example FFP2 or similar) must be worn during the Competition. This is a requirement to protect yourself and others from spreading COVID-19 virus. Should a specific skill workshop require particular PPE for Health & Safety reasons these must be followed as well.

Security

WSC2022SE accredited participants can bring to the venue specific tools and toolboxes required for their Skill.

Accreditation-only packages

For this special edition Competition, it was agreed that accreditation-only packages would be offered to participants who did not require a full duration paid package. This means that accreditation-only package holders do not have access to many of the services within the paid packages.

Accreditation

Each person who is required to be on site outside the areas open to the general public before, during, and after the Competition is required to have an accreditation badge clearly displayed.

Accreditation-only package holders will collect their accreditation from the registration desk at the Competition venue.

Important note

Members and Partners must understand that the Host incurs costs and administrative duties related to accreditation-only packages, therefore Members and Partners need to be considerate by providing accurate data.

All Members and Partners who have accreditation-only packages in the system need to assess their requirements and advise client.support@worldskills.org if there are any participants now not attending so these can be removed from the WSI system.

Please note that new accreditation-only packages cannot be added at this time.
