

There are many ATMs (automatic teller machines) where you can withdraw cash (Swiss Francs) near the hotel and at the competition venue.



The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Geneva in October is 7.5°C (45.5°F). The amount of rain in October is normal with an average of 73mm (2.9in). It rains on average a total of 10 days. The average maximum daytime temperature lies around 15.5°C (59.9°F). The sun will occasionally show itself with 108 hours of sunshine during the whole month.


Laundrette LavNet SA, Route de Meyrin 4, 1202 Genève is within walking distance (8 min.) from ibis Geneva Centre Nation.

Accreditation

Each person who is required to be on site outside the areas open to the general public before, during, and after the Competition is required to have an accreditation badge clearly displayed.

Arrivals and departures

Upon arrival at one of the specified locations those with paid packages will be transferred to their hotel. Transfers will be scheduled according to the arrival details provided in the WSI Registration System.

When it is time to depart those with paid packages will be transferred from their hotel to the specified departure locations.

Arrivals services operate on C-4, departures services operate on C+2.

If you arrive one day prior to arrivals, or depart one day after departures, please contact the Host and to confirm if transfer arrangements are possible.

Multiple packages – _for participants who have multiple packages, and your arrival and departure dates fall outside the two scenarios outlined above, you are responsible for co-ordinating your own transfers.


- There are no access restrictions to the Competition Venue common area (not the workshop area) on C1 to C4 within Competition hours for accredited participants.
- SCM, CE, DCE, E, I, C, TL, OD, TD, TDA: Access allowed as per WS Competition rules
- Other accredited participants (Member Observers, Communication Officers, CEONSO etc.): limited access allowed based on following regulations:
 - Access to observe Competition (directly in workshop) only in the set time slots on C1 to C4
 - Max. 5 persons at any one time
 - No disturbance to Competition or access will be denied
 - If status of Competition does not allow for visitors, slots may have to be cancelled
- Non-accredited visitors: no access

Prevention and control of COVID-19

International travel procedures

- **General COVID-19 travel** restrictions: Currently there are no COVID-19 travel restrictions to enter Switzerland.
- Vaccinated, recovered or tested: No proof of vaccination, recovery or testing is required for entry into Switzerland.
- **Pre-Travel-Clearance**: Currently, no Pre-Travel-Clearance is required when entering Switzerland.

IMPORTANT: In addition to the Swiss entry regulations, please also pay attention to the current rules of your country of origin by checking the official government websites. Especially ensure that you have full understanding of the requirements for re-entry back into your own country as well as countries you might be transiting through when traveling as part of WSC2022SE.

Local COVID-19 procedures

• **COVID-19 rules during your stay in Switzerland:** At this time there are no restrictions in Switzerland at a national level.

PLEASE NOTE: Since the return to a normal situation, responsibility for measures to protect the population has moved back to the regions / cantons. The measures can therefore differ from one canton to the next. Refer to bellow tab for individual cantons' official websites.

- Public meetings and events are allowed.
- If you have tested positive for COVID-19 during your stay in Switzerland: If you have tested positive for COVID-19 it is recommend to follow these rules:
 - Inform others about your test result.
 - If you feel unwell, you should stay at home and avoid or reduce contact, especially with people at high risk.
 - If you belong to the high-risk group, consider contacting your medical specialist to evaluate your early COVID-19 treatment.
 - Wear a mask if you need to be around others at home and in public.

Competition COVID-19 procedure

• **COVID-19 rules at Competition venue:** No additional COVID-19 rules other than current government guidelines are planned during the competition in Switzerland.



Security

These are the security measure to enter the Competition venue for the general public:

- Maximum size of bag is 45cm x 45cm x 30cm
- Prohibited items:
 - Alcoholic beverages of any kind;
 - Pyrotechnic articles of any kind;
 - Weapons of any kind;
 - Gas spray cans and corrosive and colouring substances;
 - Glass bottles;
 - Mobile means of transport (exception: wheelchairs); and,
 - Animals (this regulation does not apply to service dogs, rescue dogs and dogs for the disabled).

WSC2022SE accredited participants can bring to the venue all the specific tools and toolboxes required for their Skill.

No admission for public.



Accreditation-Only Packages

For this special edition Competition, it was agreed that accreditation-only packages would be offered to participants who did not require a full duration paid package. This means that accreditation-only package holders do not have access to many of the services within the paid packages.

Accreditation

Each person who is required to be on site outside the areas open to the general public before, during, and after the Competition is required to have an accreditation badge clearly displayed.

Accreditation-only package holders will collect their accreditation from the registration desk at the Competition venue.

Important note

Members and Partners must understand that the Host incurs costs and administrative duties related to accreditation-only packages, therefore Members and Partners need to be considerate by providing accurate data.

All Members and Partners who have accreditation-only packages in the system need to assess their requirements and advise <u>client.support@worldskills.org</u> if there are any participants now not attending so these can be removed from the WSI system.

Please note that new accreditation-only packages cannot be added at this time.
