You will receive accreditation cards (AD cards) on site. Please wear the AD card as this entitles you to participate in the events, transportation and will also give you access to the restaurant on the Competition site. There is an Accreditation desk in case you have any questions about access or if you have lost your AD card. If an AD card has to be reissued, the charge is JPY 3,000. Please show your passport and state the reason why you need a replacement.

Code of access: You need to have the code "6" on your badge to gain access to the Media Centre.

WSC2007 MEDIA WEBSITE

What is the WSC2007 Media website?

WorldSkills International (WSI) has created a way to capture as many photos/videos/information as possible from the Member media onsite during the WorldSkills Competition (WSC2007). In the Media Centre, WSI will have a large hard drive with a multi memory card reader for all Member media photographers to download their photos. All these photos will then be backed up onto a separate drive and put onto the WSC2007 Media website. This process is aided by simple downloading tools and easy to navigate files structures for photographers downloading their photos. Member media will be able to use any of the photos from this system once they have been uploaded on the Media website or by copying them onto an external memory drive. The Member media will not be able to delete any of the photos on the drive, they can only download and copy.

The WSC2007 Media website will be a site that has two different components:

1. Member media site: Serves as a WSC2007 information hub (press releases, media schedules, photos, interviews, etc...) for all WorldSkills International (WSI) Members during the actual event which will be updated on a daily basis. (password protected Member area)
2. Public media site: serve as a front line public centre for the general public and general media to access photos and information on a daily basis about the WSC2007.

This website will be able to help increase the effectiveness and efficiency of information getting to people that aren't onsite to see the actual event. As part of the WSI mission, we want to combine resources to create a large bank of photos and information for all Members to access whether they are onsite or back in their home countries/regions.

What is the Photo Gallery on the Media website?

On the Member media website there will be a full interactive photo gallery. Viewers are able to view all the thumbnails of the photos but also download the high resolution photos. This will all be done through an easy to navigate file structure.

On the Public media website a selection of the best photos will be made public without passwords for people to view the thumbnail and download the high resolution photos. This will all be done through an easy to navigate file structure.

Who can access the Photo Gallery on the Media website?

On the Member media website only WSI Members with usernames and passwords will be able to access these photos and information. This will be a service to all WSI Members.

On the Public media website anyone that enters the website will be able to view the photos/information.
